STARTING FIVE

 Millersville leads the all-time series against Bloomsburg, 94-90.
 However, the Huskies have won the last four, and seven of the last nine, between the two schools. Bloomsburg's last loss to the Marauders came on February 21, 2015 - a 73-60 setback in Millersville.

- With 29 points against West Chester on Monday night, Christian Mortellite has moved into second on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,780 career points. He surpassed Jerry Radocha (1973-77) who finished his career with 1,778 points. Mortellite now trails only the school's all-time leading scorer, Mike Elizy (1993-97), who scored 1,911 career points. With 13 games left in the regular season, Mortellite needs to average 10.2 points per game to break the record

- Kyle-Michael Rose became the seventh player to record 100 career blocks with three swats against Cheyney on Saturday. He blocked three more shots on Monday and moved into sixth place on the school's all-time list with 103 career blocks. Rose needs four to tie Elwood Vines (1992-93) for fifth and five to tie Chris Parker (1988-92) for fourth. He is second in the PSAC, and ninth in the country, in blocks per game (2.6).
- Bloomsburg has scored at least 92 points in three straight games
 the longest such streak since hitting the mark against Millersville,
 Shippensburg, and Kutztown from February 5 February 12, 2011.
 The Huskies are averaging 100 points over the last three games
 the highest scoring average over a three-game stretch since the
 1968-69 season
- Mortellite became the school's all-time leader in career three-pointers made with his 238th career make at IUP on November 19. Mortellite now has 270 makes for his career. The all-time Bloomsburg record (men or women) is held by Dana Wieller (2009-13) who hit 332 during her career. Mortellite would need to average 4.9 threes per game over the final 13 games of the regular season to break Wieller's record.

LAST TIME OUT ...

The Huskies trailed, 23-8, in the opening eight minutes and then trailed by 14 points, 71-57, with 13:38 left in regulation before rallying for a stunning 98-90 victory over 23rd-ranked West Chester at the Nelson Field House on Monday night to hand the Golden Rams their first loss of the season. Redshirt senior Christian Mortellite poured in a game-high 29 points - 21 in the second half - and his fifth three-pointer of the game with 3:18 left in regulation gave the Huskies an 83-80 lead. Mortellite shot 7-of-12 from the field (6-of-7 in the second half), 5-of-9 from long distance (4-of-4 in the second half), and 10-of-10 from the free throw line. Sophomore Khary Mauras added 20 points and a career-high eight assists. His biggest shot of the game came when he banked in a triple from nearly 30 feet out, with the shot clock winding down, to tie the game at 80-80 with 3:46 left in regulation. Graduate student Hashim Moore chipped in with 15 points while senior Kyle-Michael Rose added 13 points and a game-high three blocks - none bigger than a stuff at the rim on West Chester's Jackson Hyland with the Huskies leading by three with three minutes left.

Freshmen D'Marco Suggs and James Sullivan led the Marauders in the first half, and Marcus Adkison led the team down the stretch for a 70-67 road victory over Mansfield Monday evening. It was the Marauders' first road win of the season. Adkison totaled a gamehigh 21 points while adding seven rebounds and seven assists. Adkison scored 12 of those points in the second half including five in a pivotal 8-0 run that took Millersville from down three to ahead 68-63 with 1:12 left. Along with Adkison's 12 second-half points, Conrad Chambers scored eight of his 11 in the final 20 minutes. Suggs, who made 4-of-4 from the field, scored all 10 of his points in the first. Sullivan scored all 11 of his points in the first half.

SCOUTING BLOOMSBURG ...

The Huskies enter Wednesday's matchup with a 8-5 overall record and a 4-5 mark in the PSAC Eastern Division standings. The Huskies average 85.1 points per game on offense - third in the PSAC - and allow 77.6 points per game on defense - 11th in the conference. Bloomsburg is sixth in the league in rebounding margin (+1.8) and sixth in the league in turnover margin (+1.08). The Huskies average just 12.4 turnovers per game - the third-best mark in the PSAC.

Redshirt senior **Christian Mortellite** leads the Huskies, and is fourth in the PSAC, in scoring by averaging 22.8 points per game. He has scored at least 25 points seven times and has reached double figures in 12 of the 13 contests. Mortellite also leads the team, and is seventh in the PSAC, in rebounding (8.2). He also leads the team in steals (1.5) and is second in assists (3.3). Mortellite recorded his 500th career rebound at Kutztown on January 3 and posted his 200th career assist in the win over West Chester on Monday. He ranks second on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,780 career points and trails Mike Ellzy (1993-97) by 132 points to become Bloomsburg's all-time leading scorer. Sophomore **Khary Mauras** is second on the team in scoring as he averages 12.7 points per game. He leads the team in assists with 55 and is tied for seventh in the PSAC in assists per game (4.2). Mauras is also second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.5) Senior **Kyle-Michael Rose** is third on the team in scoring, averaging 12.5 points per game after averaging 5.6 points per game through his first two seasons. Rose leads the team with 34 blocked shots and is tied for second in the PSAC, and ninth in the country, in blocks per game (2.6) Rose is sixth on the school's all-time list with 103 career swats. Graduate student **Hashim Moore** has really stepped up over the last seven games. He has reached double figures in six of those contests and is averaging 13.1 points while shooting 54-of-83 (65.1%) from the field during the stretch. He averaged 3.7 points on 4-of-17 (23.5%) from the field in the first three games.

SCOUTING MILLERSVILLE ...

Millersville is 5-10 overall and 3-6 in the PSAC East. The Marauders are tied for eighth in the league in scoring offense (79.9) and 13th in the PSAC in scoring defense (79.3). Millersville struggles on the glass as it is dead last in the conference in rebounding margin (-6.5). However, the Marauders are second in the league in turnover margin (+6.07).


Millersville features three players averaging double digits in scoring the season. Marcus Adkison is the player to watch as he leads the team in scoring at 19.3 points per game - eighth in the PSAC. He also leads the team in assists (47) and steals (34) and is the main threat from beyond the arc as he has made 43 of the team's 104 triples. Conrad Chambers is second on the team in scoring at 11.8 points per game. He is second on the team in assists with 38. The duo have combined to make 104-of 119 from the foul line (87.4%) - the rest of the team is 138-of-216 (63.9%). Jordan Greene is also in double figures at 11.0 point per game. He ranks third on the team in scoring and in rebounding (5.0). Mark Perry and Caden Najdawi are tied for the team lead in rebounding (5.4).

THAT'S OFFENSIVE ...

Bloomsburg posted 110-59 victory over visiting Cheyney on Saturday, January 6. The Huskies had five double-digit scorers and all 12 players that appeared in the game scored at least two points in the victory. The 51-point margin of victory was Bloomsburg's largest since a 91-38 win over Penn State Wilkes Barre on December 7, 2009 and the 110 points scored marked the most by a Huskies' team in a single game since December 10, 1999 when Bloomsburg defeated the University of Bridgeport, 123-56. The Huskies have scored at least 92 points in three straight games - the longest streak since hitting the same mark in three straight games during the 2010-11 season (Febraury 5, 2011 - at Millersville - L 103-108 (3OT); February 9, 2011 - at Shippensburg - W 94-81; and February 12, 2011 - vs Kutztown - W 92-88). Bloomsburg is also averaging 100 points per game over the last three contests - the highest scoring average over a three-game stretch since the 1968-69 season (Kutztown (W 79-77), Lock Haven (W 104-79), Millersville (W 118-110)).

BROKEN RECORDS ...

Redshirt senior Christian Mortellite owns numerous school records and continues to assault the Bloomsburg record books. Mortellite now holds the school record for most points in a season (613), most threes in a season (110), most career threes (270), most career free throws made (398), and most three-point attempts in a season (255). He can still break several other records by season's end including most career points (needs 132), most career three-point attempts (needs seven), highest career scoring average (Richard Lloyd - 19.4), highest career three-point percentage (Joe Stepanski - 43.0%), and highest career free throw percentage (Glenn Noack - 84.6%).

MORE ON MORTELLITE ...

All eyes are on Mortellite as he attempts to become the school's all-time leading scorer. With 29 points on Monday, he moved into second place on the school's all-time list with 1,780 career points. Mortellite has 51 career 20-point efforts (92 games). He has hit double figures in 74 of his last 78 games and has been held to under 10 points in a game only 11 times in his career. Mortellite passed Jerry Radocha (1973-77) for second and needs 132 points to become the school's all-time leader.

WELCOME TO DIVISION II ...

Bloomsburg has three Division I transfers on this year's roster - sophomore Austin Harriott (Loyola (Md.)), sophomore Khary Mauras (Old Dominion), and graduate student Hashim Moore (Princeton). Mauras, the starting point guard, is second on the team in scoring (12.7) and leads the team - tied for seventh in the PSAC - in assists (4.2). Moore is averaging 10.9 points and 5.2 rebounds. Moore is averaging 13.1 points over his last ten games while shooting 54-of-83 (65.1%) from the field during the stretch. Harriott averages 7.1 points while ranking second on the team in rebounding (5.5).

DOWNTOWN WITH THE HUSKIES ...

The Huskies have made at least one three-pointer in 194 consecutive games. The last time Bloomsburg did not make a three in a game was on December 4, 2010 in a 54-51 loss at Lock Haven when it went 0-7 from beyond the arc. Bloomsburg made at least ten three-pointers in a game eight times last season after achieving that feat just one time in 2015-16. Bloomsburg has reached double digits only twice this season but has made at least five in 12 of the first 13 games. The Huskies are sixth in the PSAC, averaging 7.9 threes per game and third in percentage (38.3%).

 $\begin{array}{l} \textbf{GETTING TO THE STRIPE ...} \\ \textbf{Bloomsburg is shooting } 74.4\% \text{ from the free throw line this season - fifth} \\ \end{array}$ in the PSAC - and has outscored its opponents from the stripe in 12 of the 13 games. Bloomsburg gets to the line an average of 23.5 times per game. The Huskies are +63 from the foul line this season (227-164). Bloomsburg features three of the top 12 foul shooters in the PSAC this season - Christian Mortellite (4th, 92.4%), Khary Mauras (10th, 86.0%), and Kyle-Michael Rose (12th, 84.0%). The three have combined to hit 140-of-159 from the line (88.1%). However, the rest of the team is shooting just 87-of-146 (59.6%).

IT'S ROUGH OUT WEST ... Since the 2012-13 season, the Huskies are just 9-27 against opponents from the PSAC Western Division and just 2-16 in games played on the road against such opponents. Bloomsburg went 4-2 against PSAC West foes during the 2015-16 season - 2-1 on the road. Bloomsburg is 1-4 against West teams this season with one more game - at Seton Hill on January 17 - left on the schedule.

COMING UP ROSES ...

With his 34 blocks this season, senior Kyle-Michael Rose has moved into sixth on the school's all-time list with 103 career blocks. He became the seventh player in school history to record 100 blocked shots with three against Cheyney last Saturday. Rose is currently tied for second in the PSAC, and ninth in the country, in blocks per game (2.6).

Bloomsburg will head to East Stroudsburg University for a matchup with the Warriors on Saturday, January 13. Tipoff is scheduled for 3:00 p.m.

KACH ATTACK ...

Freshman Matthew Kachelries was named the PSAC East Freshman of the Week as announced by the league office on Monday, November 27. Kachelries posted career-highs in points (18) team's only game that week.

YOUTH MOVEMENT ...

The Huskies have three seniors and one junior on this year's roster and returned only four players from last year's team that finished 15-12. One of the three seniors - Hashim Moore - transferred in from Division I Princeton and is in his first season with the Hus-kies. Christian Mortellite and Kyle-Michael Rose are the other two Overall, Sanow has more than 25 years of experience returners from last year's team. Redshirt freshman Peyton Mortellite was on last year's roster but did not play.

HEAD COACH JOHN SANOW

John Sanow begins his 12th season as head coach of the men's basketball program at Bloomsburg in 2017-18. In his first 11 seasons with the Huskies, he has guided the program to a record of 133-163 and is second all-time in career wins in school history.

Over the last six seasons, the Huskies have made the PSAC tournament five times and earned a share of the PSAC Eastern Division regular season championship in 2011-12. Bloomsburg has gone 85-78 during the stretch.

Last year, the Huskies made the playoffs for the second year in a row only to bow out after an 84-77 setback to West Chester, at home, in the opening round of the tournament.

The highlight of the 2016-17 campaign was the play of Christian Mortellite. The sharpshooter was named to the All-PSAC Eastern Division First Team for the second year in a row after leading the country in three-pointers made per game (4.07). He was also honored as an NABC Second Team All-District - the first Husky to be recognized by the NABC since Dontahe Jordan in 2011-12. He led the Huskies in scoring (22.7), becoming the first Huskies' player since Tom Barlow, who averaged 20.3 points per game during the 2002-03 season, to average at least 20 points per game in a single campaign. Mortellite broke the single-season school record for points with 613 last year which broke the previous record of 600 set by Mike Ellzy during the 1996-97 season. He also shattered the school-record for most threes made in a season (110) and three-point attempts in a season (255).

In 2015-16, the Huskies returned to the PSAC playoffs after a one-year hiatus. Bloomsburg finished 17-10 overall and won 10 of its last 12 regular season games before suffering an 80-78 loss at Shippensburg in the opening round of the conference playoffs. The 17 victories marked the second-highest single-season total under Sanow's tutelage while the team's 15-7 mark in the PSAC East tied for the best conference mark with Sanow at the helm. Mortellite was an All-PSAC East First Team honoree.

Sanow helped guide the Huskies to three straight PSAC postseason appearances from 2012 to 2014 the longest streak for the school since an eight-year run from 1995 to 2002. The Huskies earned the third seed from the Eastern Division in the 2013-14 PSAC playoffs and picked up a first round victory over Kutztown, ultimately finishing the season at 16-12 overall and 10-6 in conference play. It was Bloomsburg's first postseason win since the 2002 playoffs. Following the season, Dontahe Jordan was named First Team All-PSAC East while fellow senior Lorenzo Christmas earned a spot on the Second Team. Both players finsteals (4), and blocked shots (3) as he helped the Huskies to an ished their careers with more than 1,000 points with 86-67 victory over Holy Family on Tuesday, November 21, in the Christmas owning the school's all-time record for made three-pointers and Jordan became one of only five players in BU history to reach both 1,000 points and 700 rebounds. He also coached Alssene Saintilus, who signed a contract to play professionally in Italy following the 2014-15 season.

> Sanow was named PSAC East Coach of the Year in 2011-12 after leading the Huskies to 19 victories. That season, Sanow produced one of the best men's basketball seasons at Bloomsburg in recent memory. He led the Huskies to a 19-9 record, their best showing in

11 years, and a share of the PSAC Eastern crown. The Huskies also made a trip to the PSAC playoffs for the first time in 10 seasons and hosted their first home playoff game since the 1998-99 season. Sanow coached the PSAC Eastern Player of the Year in Dontahe Jordan, who also earned NABC All-District First Team honors and Daktronics Atlantic Region Second Team honors, as well as the PSAC Eastern Defensive Athlete of the Year in Larry Webster, who would later go on to play in the NFL with the Detroit Lions.

Sanow's players also reached career milestones in the 2011-12 season. Both Trevon Johnson and Webster scored their 1,000th career points under Sanow's tutelage. They were the first Bloomsburg players to reach the 1,000 point plateau in five years. In addition, Webster cemented his place among Bloomsburg greats by ending his career as Bloomsburg's all-time shot blocker with 175 career rejections.

In 2010-11, the Huskies narrowly missed out on reaching the PSAC playoffs losing out on the final game of the year. The Huskies seven PSAC Eastern Division wins were the most for the team since the 2000-01 season. Sanow also coached the PSAC Eastern Division Rookie of the Year in Dontahe Jordan. During the season Jordan was named the PSAC East Rookie of the Week seven times.

In 2009-10, the Huskies just missed out on the PSAC playoffs after dropping its final game of the season. Among the 12 wins for the Huskies was a 12-point victory over seventh-ranked Kutztown. Bloomsburg also lost several close games suffering four defeats in overtime.

In his first season with the Huskies in 2006-07, Sanow guided the Huskies to a mark of 13-14, an improvement of seven wins from the previous season and the first time since 2001-02 that the team reached double figures in wins. Sanow won his first six games as coach and had the team nationally ranked for the first time in several years. He also closed out the season winning four of the final five games and just missed out on a berth in the PSAC playoffs. Also, the eight wins the Huskies recorded at the Nelson Field House were the most since the team won 10 in 2000-01.

A native of Windber, Pa., who is well connected in basketball in the East, Sanow is a 1987 graduate of Indiana (Pa.) University. After transferring from Clarion University in 1984, he led IUP in scoring and was an All-PSAC First Team selection in 1986. He also set numerous three-point shooting records for the Indians.

At Vermont in 2005-06, he was part of a new coaching staff that led the least-experienced team in the nation in D-I (no seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and seven freshmen) to the America East Championship game for the fourth straight season. The sixth-seed-ed Catamounts (13-17, 7-9 America East) topped #3 Boston University and #2 Binghamton before falling at top-seeded Albany in the title game.

While at St. Francis (Pa.), he was an integral part of the Red Flash winning the 1991 Northeast Conference title and a trip to the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship. In 1992, he also was an assistant coach for the Panama Men's Olympic Team in its attempt to qualify for the Summer Olympics in Barcelona. While at St. Francis, he coached Mike luzzolino, who went on to play for the NBA's Dallas Mavericks.
