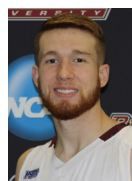

STARTING FIVE

- BloomSBurg leads the all-time series against Seton Hill, 2-1. The teams last met on November 21, 2015 in Seton Hill with the Huskies prevailing with an 88-74 final.

- With 29 points against West Chester on January 6, Christian Mortellite moved into second on the school's all-time scoring list as he now has 1,815 career points. He surpassed Jerry Radocha (1973-77) who finished his career with 1,778 points. Mortellite now trails only the school's all-time leading scorer, Mike Elzy (1993-97), who scored 1,911 career points. With 11 games left in the regular season, Mortellite needs to average 8.8 points per game to break the record.

- Kyle-Michael Rose became the seventh player to record 100 career blocks with three swats against Cheyney on January 6. He has now moved into third place on the school's all-time list with 111 career blocks. With four blocks on Saturday, he broke a tie with Elwood Vines and passed both Chris Parker and Matt Jefferson. He needs 19 blocks to tie Lee Gump (1992-96) for second on the career list. He is second in the PSAC, and seventh in the country, in blocks per game (2.8). Wednesday's matchup will feature the top two shot blockers in the PSAC - Spencer Casson of Seton Hill (3.0 bpg) and Rose (2.8 bpg).

- Prior to Saturday's 98-62 loss at East Stroudsburg, the Huskies had scored at least 90 points in four straight games - the longest streak in program history. BloomSBurg had done it in three straight games three times with the most recent coming in the 2010-11 season (February 5, 2011 - at Millersville - L 103-108 (3OT); February 9, 2011 - at Shippensburg - W 94-81; and February 12, 2011 - vs Kutztown - W 92-88). However, the season-low in points on Saturday against the Warriors ended the streak at four.

- Mortellite became the school's all-time leader in career three-pointers made with his 238th career make at IUP on November 19. Mortellite now has 276 makes for his career. The all-time BloomSBurg record (men or women) is held by Dana Wieller (2009-13) who hit 332 during her career.

THE SERIES ...

The Huskies and the Griffins have met just three prior times in the all-time series with Bloomsburg holding a 2-1 series advantage. In the last meeting between the two schools, the Huskies won in Greensburg by an 88-74 final. Christian Mortellite led all scorers with a game-high 31 points while Tyriek Steward (12) and Anthony McKie (11) also reached double figures. Kameron Taylor led the Griffins with 30 points in a losing effort.

LAST TIME OUT ...

Bloomsburg's offensive streak came to a screeching halt on Saturday afternoon as East Stroudsburg shut down the Huskies' offense en route to a 98-62 victory at the Koehler Fieldhouse. It was a season-low in points for the Huskies, who dropped to 9-6 overall and 5-6 in the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Eastern Division. Senior Kyle-Michael Rose posted his second double-double of the season with 16 points and 11 rebounds while adding four blocked shots. Redshirt senior Christian Mortellite needed a late burst to get into double figures as he finished the afternoon with 11 points while Freshman Ethan Houston had a strong game off of the Huskies' bench as he chipped in with eight points and six rebounds. East Stroudsburg set the tone of the game early as it raced out to a 17-2 lead in the first seven minutes and never looked back. Bloomsburg shot just 21-of-63 (33.3%) and tied a season-low with four three-pointers in 17 attempts (23.5%). The Huskies did make 16-of-17 at the foul line (94.1%).

Trevor Blondin scored a career-high 32 points including the game-winning shot with one second remaining in overtime as Seton Hill came back from an 11-point, second-half deficit to defeat California (PA), 90-87, on Saturday afternoon inside the Katherine Mabis McKenna Center. For the game, Trevor Blondin led all scorers with a career-high 32 points on 10-of-23 from the field, including 4-of-9 from the three-point range. Freshman Tommy Sekunda had career-highs in points (15), field goals made and attempted (6-for-10), and three-point field goals made and attempted (3-of-6). Trevor Lecuona had 13 points and Spencer Casson added the only double-double of the game with 10 points and 10 rebounds. Casson also had five blocks.

SCOUTING BLOOMSBURG ...

The Huskies enter Wednesday's matchup with a 9-6 overall record and a 5-6 mark in the PSAC Eastern Division standings. The Huskies, who lost 98-62 at East Stroudsburg on Saturday, have won three of their last four, and five of their last seven contests. The Huskies are averaging 91.4 points over their last five and are fifth in the PSAC in scoring at 84.2 points per game. Bloomsburg allows 78.6 points per game on defense - tied for 10th in the conference. The team is tied for sixth in the league in rebounding margin (+1.1) and tenth in the league in turnover margin (+0.33). Despite a season-high 24 turnovers on Saturday, the Huskies average just 13.1 turnovers per game - the fifth-best mark in the PSAC.

Redshirt senior **Christian Mortellite** leads the Huskies, and is fifth in the PSAC, in scoring by averaging 22.1 points per game. He has scored at least 25 points seven times and has reached double figures in 14 of the 15 contests. Mortellite also leads the team, and is tied for ninth in the PSAC, in rebounding (7.6). He also leads the team in steals (1.5) and is second in assists (3.3). Mortellite recorded his 500th career rebound at Kutztown on January 3 and posted his 200th career assist in the win over West Chester on January 8. He ranks second on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,815 career points and trails Mike Ellzy (1993-97) by 97 points to become Bloomsburg's all-time leading scorer. Senior **Kyle-Michael Rose** is second on the team in scoring, averaging 12.9 points per game after averaging 5.6 points per game through his first two seasons. Rose leads the team with 42 blocked shots and is second in the PSAC, and seventh in the country, in blocks per game (2.8). Rose is third on the school's all-time list with 111 career swats. Sophomore **Khary Mauras** is third on the team in scoring as he averages 12.2 points per game. He leads the team in assists with 59 and is tied for ninth in the PSAC in assists per game (3.9). Despite struggling on Saturday, graduate student **Hashim Moore** has really stepped up over the last 12 games. He has reached double figures in eight of those contests and is averaging 12.4 points while shooting 60-of-95 (63.2%) from the field during the stretch. He averaged 3.7 points on 4-of-17 (23.5%) from the field in the first three games.

SCOUTING SETON HILL ...

The Griffins enter Wednesday's contest with a 6-10 overall record and a 3-8 mark in the PSAC West. Seton Hill ranks 14th in the league in scoring offense (75.3) and 15th in scoring defense (82.2). The Griffins are 13th in the league in rebounding margin (-1.8) and dead last in the conference in turnover margin (-5.25). Seton Hill averages 17.1 turnovers per game while forcing opponents into just 11.8 miscues per contest.

Trevor Blondin leads the Griffins in scoring as he averages 20.5 points per game. He has played only 11 games - just shy of the games needed to qualify for the league's scoring title. He would be tied for seventh in the PSAC. Blondin has reached double figures in all 11 of his games and has scored at least 20 points seven times including a career-high 32 points on Saturday against California. **Nathan Davis** is the only other Griffin averaging double figures as he posts 13.6 points per contest. Davis leads Seton Hill with 32 three-pointers and is second in rebounding (5.5) and assists (3.6). **Trevor Lecuona** is at 9.8 points per game and has made 45.7% of his three-point attempts (21-of-46). Lecuona averages 3.8 rebounds while leading the team in assists with 56. The man in the middle is **Spencer Casson** who is in a battle with Bloomsburg's Kyle-Michael Rose for the top shot-blocker in the league. Casson averages 8.5 points and a team-high 6.7 rebounds while leading the league in blocked shots per game (3.0). Casson had a season-high nine swats and narrowly missed a triple-double against Mansfield (18 points, 15 rebounds). He has had three double-doubles this season.

MORTELLITE NAMED PSAC EAST CO-ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

Redshirt senior Christian Mortellite was named the PSAC East Co-Athlete of the Week as he led Bloomsburg to a 2-1 record during the week, including a victory over previously-unbeaten and 23rd-ranked West Chester last Monday night. Mortellite averaged 21.3 points, 4.3 rebounds, and 3.3 assists over the course of the three games and moved into second place on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,815 career points. He is just 97 points away from becoming the school's all-time leading scorer. Mortellite shot 21-of-38 (55.3%) from the field, 11-of-21 (52.4%) from three-point range, and 11-of-11 from the foul line. He scored 29 points in the win over West Chester and 24 points in a victory at Millersville on Wednesday.

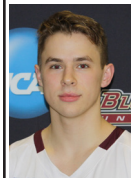

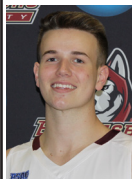

THAT'S OFFENSIVE ...

Bloomsburg posted 110-59 victory over visiting Cheyney on Saturday, January 6. The Huskies had five double-digit scorers and all 12 players that appeared in the game scored at least two points in the victory. The 51-point margin of victory was Bloomsburg's largest since a 91-38 win over Penn State Wilkes Barre on December 7, 2009 and the 110 points scored marked the most by a Huskies' team in a single game since December 10, 1999 when Bloomsburg defeated the University of Bridgeport, 123-56. Prior to Saturday's 98-62 loss at East Stroudsburg, the Huskies had scored at least 90 points in four straight games - the longest streak in program history. Bloomsburg had done it in three straight games three times with the most recent coming in the 2010-11 season (February 5, 2011 - at Millersville - L 103-108 (3OT); February 9, 2011 - at Shippensburg - W 94-81; and February 12, 2011 - vs Kutztown - W 92-88).

BROKEN RECORDS ...

Redshirt senior Christian Mortellite owns numerous school records and continues to assault the Bloomsburg record books. Mortellite now holds the school record for most points in a season (613), most threes in a season (110), most career threes (276), most career free throws made (399), most three-point attempts in a season (255), and most career three-point attempts (651). He can still break several other records by season's end including most career points (needs 97), highest career scoring average (Richard Lloyd - 19.4), highest career three-point percentage (Joe Stepanski - 43.0%), and highest career free throw percentage (Glenn Noack - 84.6%).

MORE ON MORTELLITE ...

All eyes are on Mortellite as he attempts to become the school's all-time leading scorer. With 29 points against West Chester on January 8, he moved into second place on the school's all-time list and now has 1,815 career points. Mortellite has 52 career 20-point efforts (94 games). He has hit double figures in 76 of his last 80 games and has been held to under 10 points in a game only 11 times in his career. Mortellite passed Jerry Radocha (1973-77) for second and needs 97 points to become the school's all-time leader.

WELCOME TO DIVISION II ...

Bloomsburg has three Division I transfers on this year's roster - sophomore Austin Harriott (Loyola (Md.)), sophomore Khary Mauras (Old Dominion), and graduate student Hashim Moore (Princeton). Mauras, the starting point guard, is third on the team in scoring (12.2) and leads the team - tied for ninth in the PSAC - in assists (3.9). Moore is averaging 10.6 points and 5.2 rebounds. Over his last 12 games, Moore is averaging 12.4 points while shooting 60-of-95 (63.2%) from the field during the stretch. Harriott averages 7.1 points while ranking tied for third on the team in rebounding (5.2).

DOWNTOWN WITH THE HUSKIES ...

The Huskies have made at least one three-pointer in 196 consecutive games. The last time Bloomsburg did not make a three in a game was on December 4, 2010 in a 54-51 loss at Lock Haven when it went 0-7 from beyond the arc. Bloomsburg made at least ten three-pointers in a game eight times last season after achieving that feat just one time in 2015-16. Bloomsburg has reached double digits only twice this season but has made at least five in 13 of its 15 games. The Huskies are sixth in the PSAC, averaging 7.6 threes per game and fourth in percentage (38.0%).

GETTING TO THE STRIPE ...

Bloomsburg is shooting 75.7% from the free throw line this season - fourth in the PSAC - and has outscored its opponents from the stripe in 14 of the 15 games. Bloomsburg gets to the line an average of 23.0 times per game. The Huskies are +83 from the foul line this season (261-178). Bloomsburg features three of the top 12 foul shooters in the PSAC this season - Christian Mortellite (3rd, 92.5%), Khary Mauras (11th, 85.1%), and Kyle-Michael Rose (12th, 84.7%). The three have combined to hit 152-of-173 from the line (87.9%). The rest of the team is shooting 109-of-172 (63.4%).

IT'S ROUGH OUT WEST ...

Since the 2012-13 season, the Huskies are just 9-27 against opponents from the PSAC Western Division and just 2-16 in games played on the road against such opponents. Bloomsburg went 4-2 against PSAC West foes during the 2015-16 season - 2-1 on the road. Bloomsburg is 1-4 against West teams this season with one more game - at Seton Hill on January 17 - left on the schedule.

COMING UP ROSES ...

With his 42 blocks this season, senior Kyle-Michael Rose has moved into third place on the school's all-time list with 111 career blocks. He became the seventh player in school history to record 100 blocked shots with three against Cheyney on January 6. Rose is currently tied for second in the PSAC, and seventh in the country, in blocks per game (2.8). He needs 19 blocks to tie Lee Gump (1992-96) for second.

KACH ATTACK ...

Freshman Matthew Kachelries was named the PSAC East Freshman of the Week as announced by the league office on Monday, November 27. Kachelries posted career-highs in points (18), steals (4), and blocked shots (3) as he helped the Huskies to an 86-67 victory over Holy Family on Tuesday, November 21, in the team's only game that week.

YOUTH MOVEMENT ...

The Huskies have three seniors and one junior on this year's roster and returned only four players from last year's team that finished 15-12. One of the three seniors - Hashim Moore - transferred in from Division I Princeton and is in his first season with the Huskies. Christian Mortellite and Kyle-Michael Rose are the other two seniors on the team while redshirt junior Darius Robinson-Wallace and redshirt sophomore Sam Saxton join the duo as the only other returners from last year's team. Redshirt freshman Peyton Mortellite was on last year's roster but did not play.

HEAD COACH JOHN SANOW

John Sanow begins his 12th season as head coach of the men's basketball program at Bloomsburg in 2017-18. In his first 11 seasons with the Huskies, he has guided the program to a record of 133-163 and is second all-time in career wins in school history.

Over the last six seasons, the Huskies have made the PSAC tournament five times and earned a share of the PSAC Eastern Division regular season championship in 2011-12. Bloomsburg has gone 85-78 during the stretch.

Last year, the Huskies made the playoffs for the second year in a row only to bow out after an 84-77 setback to West Chester, at home, in the opening round of the tournament.

The highlight of the 2016-17 campaign was the play of Christian Mortellite. The sharpshooter was named to the All-PSAC Eastern Division First Team for the second year in a row after leading the country in three-pointers made per game (4.07). He was also honored as an NABC Second Team All-District - the first Husky to be recognized by the NABC since Dontahe Jordan in 2011-12. He led the Huskies in scoring (22.7), becoming the first Huskies' player since Tom Barlow, who averaged 20.3 points per game during the 2002-03 season, to average at least 20 points per game in a single campaign. Mortellite broke the single-season school record for points with 613 last year which broke the previous record of 600 set by Mike Elly during the 1996-97 season. He also shattered the school-record for most threes made in a season (110) and three-point attempts in a season (255).

In 2015-16, the Huskies returned to the PSAC playoffs after a one-year hiatus. Bloomsburg finished 17-10 overall and won 10 of its last 12 regular season games before suffering an 80-78 loss at Shippensburg in the opening round of the conference playoffs. The 17 victories marked the second-highest single-season total under Sanow's tutelage while the team's 15-7 mark in the PSAC East tied for the best conference mark with Sanow at the helm. Mortellite was an All-PSAC East First Team honoree.

Sanow helped guide the Huskies to three straight PSAC postseason appearances from 2012 to 2014 - the longest streak for the school since an eight-year run from 1995 to 2002. The Huskies earned the third seed from the Eastern Division in the 2013-14 PSAC playoffs and picked up a first round victory over Kutztown, ultimately finishing the season at 16-12 overall and 10-6 in conference play. It was Bloomsburg's first postseason win since the 2002 playoffs. Following the season, Dontahe Jordan was named First Team All-PSAC East while fellow senior Lorenzo Christmas earned a spot on the Second Team. Both players finished their careers with more than 1,000 points with Christmas owning the school's all-time record for made three-pointers and Jordan became one of only five players in BU history to reach both 1,000 points and 700 rebounds. He also coached Alssene Saintilus, who signed a contract to play professionally in Italy following the 2014-15 season.

Overall, Sanow has more than 25 years of experience with previous coaching stops at the University of Vermont along with Division II schools Gannon University and Pitt-Johnstown. He also spent 11 years as an assistant coach at Division I St. Francis of Pennsylvania.

Sanow was named PSAC East Coach of the Year in 2011-12 after leading the Huskies to 19 victories. That season, Sanow produced one of the best men's basketball seasons at Bloomsburg in recent memory. He led the Huskies to a 19-9 record, their best showing in

11 years, and a share of the PSAC Eastern crown. The Huskies also made a trip to the PSAC playoffs for the first time in 10 seasons and hosted their first home play-off game since the 1998-99 season. Sanow coached the PSAC Eastern Player of the Year in Dontahe Jordan, who also earned NABC All-District First Team honors and Daktronics Atlantic Region Second Team honors, as well as the PSAC Eastern Defensive Athlete of the Year in Larry Webster, who would later go on to play in the NFL with the Detroit Lions.

Sanow's players also reached career milestones in the 2011-12 season. Both Trevon Johnson and Webster scored their 1,000th career points under Sanow's tutelage. They were the first Bloomsburg players to reach the 1,000 point plateau in five years. In addition, Webster cemented his place among Bloomsburg greats by ending his career as Bloomsburg's all-time shot blocker with 175 career rejections.

In 2010-11, the Huskies narrowly missed out on reaching the PSAC playoffs losing out on the final game of the year. The Huskies seven PSAC Eastern Division wins were the most for the team since the 2000-01 season. Sanow also coached the PSAC Eastern Division Rookie of the Year in Dontahe Jordan. During the season Jordan was named the PSAC East Rookie of the Week seven times.

In 2009-10, the Huskies just missed out on the PSAC playoffs after dropping its final game of the season. Among the 12 wins for the Huskies was a 12-point victory over seventh-ranked Kutztown. Bloomsburg also lost several close games suffering four defeats in overtime.

In his first season with the Huskies in 2006-07, Sanow guided the Huskies to a mark of 13-14, an improvement of seven wins from the previous season and the first time since 2001-02 that the team reached double figures in wins. Sanow won his first six games as coach and had the team nationally ranked for the first time in several years. He also closed out the season winning four of the final five games and just missed out on a berth in the PSAC playoffs. Also, the eight wins the Huskies recorded at the Nelson Field House were the most since the team won 10 in 2000-01.

A native of Windber, Pa., who is well connected in basketball in the East, Sanow is a 1987 graduate of Indiana (Pa.) University. After transferring from Clarion University in 1984, he led IUP in scoring and was an All-PSAC First Team selection in 1986. He also set numerous three-point shooting records for the Indians.

At Vermont in 2005-06, he was part of a new coaching staff that led the least-experienced team in the nation in D-I (no seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and seven freshmen) to the America East Championship game for the fourth straight season. The sixth-seeded Catamounts (13-17, 7-9 America East) topped #3 Boston University and #2 Binghamton before falling at top-seeded Albany in the title game.

While at St. Francis (Pa.), he was an integral part of the Red Flash winning the 1991 Northeast Conference title and a trip to the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship. In 1992, he also was an assistant coach for the Panama Men's Olympic Team in its attempt to qualify for the Summer Olympics in Barcelona. While at St. Francis, he coached Mike Iuzzolino, who went on to play for the NBA's Dallas Mavericks.
