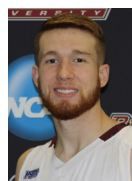

#### STARTING FIVE

- Bloomsburg leads the all-time series against East Stroudsburg, 92-74, but the Warriors have won 10 of the last 11 meetings between the two schools. Bloomsburg's only win during the stretch was a 91-84 victory at East Stroudsburg on January 30, 2016. Both teams have already clinched spots in the conference tournament later this month.

- With 18:54 left in regulation on January 31 against Kutztown, Christian Mortellite became the program's all-time leading scorer as he passed Mike Elby's total of 1,911 from 1993-97. He needs 27 points to become the 12th player in PSAC history to record 2,000 career points. He currently ranks 13th on the PSAC's all-time scoring list with 1,973 points and trails Cheyney's Anthony Frazier by 26 points to move into 12th position.

- Kyle-Michael Rose became the seventh player to record 100 career blocks with three swats against Cheyney on January 6. He has moved into third place on the school's all-time list with 127 career blocks and needs three blocks to tie Lee Gump (1992-96) for second on the career list. He is third in the PSAC, and 13th in the country, in blocks per game (2.52).

- The Huskies have made at least one three-pointer in 204 consecutive games. The last time Bloomsburg did not make a three in a game was on December 4, 2010 in a 54-51 loss at Lock Haven when it went 0-7 from beyond the arc. Bloomsburg has reached double digits only four times this season but has made at least five in 19 of its 23 games. The Huskies are sixth in the PSAC, averaging 7.5 threes per game and fifth in percentage (37.1%).

- Speaking of three-pointers, Mortellite has made 301 triples in his career and ranks eighth on the PSAC's all-time list. He became only the eighth player in conference history to record 300 career triples midway through the second half against Millersville on Saturday. He trails Lock Haven's Mike Shue (1993-97) by seven to move into seventh place on the PSAC's all-time list.

The Warriors handed the Huskies their worst loss of the season, 98-62, back on January 13 in East Stroudsburg.

## LAST TIME OUT ...

Bloomington outscored visiting Millersville, 35-19, over the final 10:44 of regulation as the Huskies knocked off the Marauders, 89-78, at the Nelson Field House on Saturday afternoon. The victory secured a postseason berth for the Huskies for the third consecutive season and the sixth time in the last seven years. Graduate student Hashim Moore led four Huskies in double figures with 22 points on 10-of-12 shooting from the field. Redshirt senior Christian Mortellite added 21 points which included going 4-of-5 from three-point range. With his third triple of the game, he became only the eighth player in PSAC history to record 300 career three-pointers and, with his 21 points, moved to within 27 points of becoming just the 12th player in conference history to register 2,000 points for his career. Senior Kyle-Michael Rose also had a sensational game for the Huskies as he posted 19 points and a career-high 13 rebounds for his second consecutive double-double. Sophomore Khary Mauraas chipped in with 15 points and five assists for the Huskies, who completed the season sweep over the Marauders.

East Stroudsburg put six players in double figures, led by 14 points by redshirt junior forward Josh Williams, in a 95-74 win at Cheyney on Monday night at Cope Hall. Junior guard Nick Giordano scored 13 points, redshirt junior guard Jakwan Jones and sophomore forward Kobi Nwandu scored 12 and redshirt senior forward Steve Harris and senior forward Malik Wise had 11 each for ESU. Jones added six rebounds, six assists, and three of the Warriors' 16 steals, and sophomore guard Montrel Morgan had eight points. ESU, which led by as many as 34 in the second half, won its 19th straight against Cheyney since the Wolves won both meetings in 2008-09.

## SCOUTING BLOOMINGTON ...

The Huskies enter Wednesday's matchup with a 14-9 overall record and a 10-9 mark in the PSAC East. The Huskies have a stranglehold on fifth-place in the division and have clinched a spot in the PSAC tournament for the third straight year, and sixth time in the last seven seasons. Bloomington is fifth in the PSAC in scoring at 82.5 points per game and ranks 10th in the league in scoring defense at 77.5. The team is sixth in the league in rebounding margin (+1.9) and 12th in the league in turnover margin (-0.17). The Huskies average just 13.0 turnovers per game - tied for the fourth-best mark in the PSAC.

Redshirt senior **Christian Mortellite** leads the Huskies, and is tied for fifth in the PSAC, in scoring by averaging 21.3 points per game. He has scored at least 25 points eight times and has reached double figures in 22 of the 23 contests. On January 31 against Kutztown, Mortellite became the school's all-time leading scorer as he surpassed Mike Elzy (1993-97) who finished his career with 1,911 points. He needs 27 points to become the 12th player in PSAC history to record 2,000 career points and currently ranks 13th on the PSAC's all-time scoring list with 1,973 points. He became the eighth player in PSAC history to record 300 three-pointers against Millersville on Saturday and ranks in conference history with 301. Mortellite also leads the team in rebounding (7.0), is second in steals (1.3), and is second in assists (2.8). He is third in the PSAC in threes-per-game (3.22) and is third in the league in free-throw percentage (90.5%; 95-of-105). Sophomore **Khary Mauraas** is second on the team in scoring as he averages 13.1 points per game. He recorded what is believed to be the program's first triple-double (21 pts, 11 reb, 13 ast) against Lock Haven on February 3 - three days after his first career double-double (12 pts, 10 reb) against Kutztown on January 31. Mauraas is averaging 15.0 points, 6.4 rebounds, and 5.5 assists over the last eight games. He leads the team in assists (103) and steals (39) and ranks tied for sixth in the PSAC in assists per game (4.5), tied for ninth in steals (1.7), and tied for fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1). Senior **Kyle-Michael Rose** is third on the team in scoring, averaging 13.1 points per game after averaging 5.6 points per game through his first two seasons. He ranks second on the team in rebounding (6.1) and free-throw percentage (82.6%; 76-of-92). Rose leads the team with 58 blocked shots and is third in the PSAC, and 13th in the country, in blocks per game (2.52). He is third on the school's all-time list with 127 career swats.

## SCOUTING EAST STROUDSBURG ...

East Stroudsburg is 17-5 overall and sits in a tie for second (with Shippensburg) in the PSAC East entering Wednesday's game with a conference record of 14-4 - just one-half game behind West Chester for the top spot in the division. The Warriors have won three straight and six of their last seven. The Warriors are first in the league in scoring offense (93.6) but is only 11th in scoring defense (79.2). ESU is only 10th in the conference in rebounding margin is (-0.5) but the Warriors take care of the ball as they rank first in the PSAC in turnover margin (+8.18). ESU ranks third in the league in field goal percentage (48.3%) and feature three players averaging double-digits in scoring. **Steve Harris** is the player to watch for the Warriors as he leads the team in scoring at 14.5 points per game. Harris also leads the Warriors in rebounds (7.0) and blocked shots (27) while shooting a PSAC-best 64.6% from the field. **Kobi Nwandu** is second on the team in scoring at 12.5 points per game on 56.3% shooting. **Nick Giordano** is third in scoring at 11.2 points per game and ranks second on the team in steals (37) while leading the team in three-pointers (52). **Malik Wise** averages 9.4 points and 5.4 rebounds per game as the first player off the bench.

## ROSE NAMED PSAC EAST ATHLETE OF THE WEEK ...

Senior Kyle-Michael Rose was named the PSAC East Athlete of the Week on Monday afternoon - the first time in his career that he was honored by the league with a weekly award. He posted back-to-back double-doubles to lead the Huskies to a pair of victories. In last Wednesday's 75-58 win at Cheyney, Rose led the Huskies with 19 points, going 8-of-12 from the field, while pulling down 11 rebounds. He added two assists and two blocked shots in the victory. Then, on Saturday, Rose posted 19 points on 8-of-11 shooting and grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds to lift the Huskies to an 89-78 home win over Millersville on Senior Day. He added two more assists and two more blocked shots in the victory. For the week, Rose averaged 19.0 points, 12.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, and 2.0 blocks while shooting 16-of-23 (69.6%) from the field. Rose now has four double-doubles this season and six for his career.

## BROKEN RECORDS ...

Christian Mortellite became the school's all-time leading scorer against Kutztown on January 31 - just another added to the laundry list of records he currently owns. Mortellite now holds the school record for most career points (1,973), most points in a season (613), most threes in a season (110), most career threes made (301), most career free throws made (432), most three-point attempts in a season (255), and most career three-point attempts (708). He could still break several other records by season's end including most career field goals made (needs 73), most career free throws attempted (needs 49), highest career scoring average (Richard Lloyd - 19.4), highest career three-point percentage (Joe Stepanski - 43.0%), and highest career free throw percentage (Glenn Noack - 84.6%). Mortellite is currently 13th on the PSAC's all-time scoring list and needs 27 points to become the 12th player in conference history to reach 2,000 for his career. Meanwhile, he is eighth in PSAC history in career three-pointers made with 301.

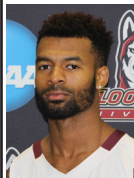

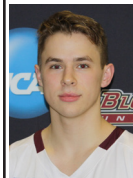

### HISTORIC WEEK ...

Two historic accomplishments were achieved in the span of three days at the Nelson Field House for the Bloomsburg men's basketball program. On Wednesday, January 31, Christian Mortellite became the school's all-time leading scorer after a driving layup with 18:54 left in regulation against Kutztown. The basket gave him 1,913 points for his career, surpassing Mike Elzy's previous record of 1,911 from 1993-97. Then, on Saturday, February 3, sophomore Khary Mauraas recorded what is believed to be the program's first-ever triple-double in an eight-point win over Lock Haven. Mauraas had 21 points, 11 rebounds, and 13 assists, recording the 19th triple-double in Division II this season and only the second by a PSAC player (Seton Hill's Spencer Casson had the first).

### DOWNTOWN WITH THE HUSKIES ...

The Huskies have made at least one three-pointer in 204 consecutive games. The last time Bloomsburg did not make a three in a game was on December 4, 2010 in a 54-51 loss at Lock Haven when it went 0-7 from beyond the arc. Bloomsburg made at least ten three-pointers in a game eight times last season after achieving that feat just one time in 2015-16. Bloomsburg has reached double digits only four times this season but has made at least five in 19 of its 23 games. The Huskies are sixth in the PSAC, averaging 7.5 threes per game and fifth in percentage (37.1%).

### GETTING TO THE STRIPE ...

Bloomsburg is shooting 74.1% from the free throw line this season - fifth in the PSAC - and has outscored its opponents from the stripe in 19 of the 23 games. The Huskies are +106 from the foul line this season (381-275). Bloomsburg features three of the top ten foul shooters in the PSAC this season - Christian Mortellite (3rd, 90.5%), Kyle-Michael Rose (9th, 82.6%), and Khary Mauraas (10th, 81.1%). The home win over Lock Haven on February 3, marked the first time this season that Bloomsburg won despite being outscored (1-3) and out-attempted (1-5) from the foul line.

### COMING UP ROSES ...

With his 58 blocks this season, senior Kyle-Michael Rose has moved into third place on the school's all-time list with 127 career blocks. The 58 blocks this season are the most by a Bloomsburg player since Larry Webster swatted 61 shots during the 2009-10 campaign. Rose became the seventh player in school history to record 100 blocked shots with three against Cheyney on January 6. He is currently third in the PSAC, and 13th in the country, in blocks per game (2.52) and needs three blocks to tie Lee Gump (1992-96) for second on the school's all-time list.

### WELCOME TO DIVISION II ...

Bloomsburg has three Division I transfers on this year's roster - sophomore Austin Harriott (Loyola (Md.)), sophomore Khary Mauraas (Old Dominion), and graduate student Hashim Moore (Princeton). Mauraas, the starting point guard, is second on the team in scoring (13.2) and leads the team - tied for sixth in the PSAC - in assists (4.5). He posted what is believed to be the program's first-ever triple-double (21 pts, 11 reb, 13 ast) against Lock Haven on February 3. Moore is averaging 10.9 points and 4.9 rebounds. After opening the season by averaging 3.7 points in his first three games, Moore is averaging 12.0 points, while shooting 99-of-159 (62.3%) from the field over his last 20 games. Harriott averages 6.8 points while ranking third on the team in rebounding (5.7) and second in blocks (19). He posted his first career double-double (11 pts, 11 reb) at Cheyney last Wednesday.

### MORE ON MORTELLITE ...

Mortellite has 55 career 20-point efforts (102 games) and eight career 30-point games. He has hit double figures in 84 of his last 88 games and has been held to under 10 points in a game only 11 times in his career. The redshirt senior now needs 27 points to become the 12th player in PSAC history to record 2,000 career points. He currently ranks 13th on the PSAC's all-time scoring list with 1,973 points and trails Cheyney's Charlie Parker by 26 points to move into 12th place on the PSAC's all-time list. He is also eighth on the PSAC's all-time list in career three-pointers with 301 and needs seven to tie Lock Haven's Mike Shue (1993-97) for seventh.

### THAT'S OFFENSIVE ...

Bloomsburg posted 110-59 victory over visiting Cheyney on January 6. The Huskies had five double-digit scorers and all 12 players that appeared in the game scored at least two points in the victory. The 51-point margin of victory was Bloomsburg's largest since a 91-38 win over Penn State Wilkes Barre on December 7, 2009 and the 110 points scored marked the most by a Huskies' team in a single game since December 10, 1999 when Bloomsburg defeated the University of Bridgeport, 123-56. Prior to the 98-62 loss at East Stroudsburg on January 13, the Huskies had scored at least 90 points in four straight games - the longest streak in program history. Bloomsburg had done it in three straight games three times with the most recent coming in the 2010-11 season.

### UP NEXT ...

The Huskies will be off until next Wednesday, February 21, when they hit the road to battle Mansfield University at 7:30 p.m. Bloomsburg will be looking to avenge a 92-85 loss to the Mountaineers at the Nelson Field House back on January 20.

#### MORTELLITE NAMED CO-ATHLETE OF THE WEEK ...

Christian Mortellite was named the PSAC East Co-Athlete of the Week on Tuesday, January 16 as he led Bloomsburg to a 2-1 record during the week, including a victory over previously-unbeaten and 23rd-ranked West Chester on January 8. Mortellite averaged 21.3 points, 4.3 rebounds, and 3.3 assists over the course of the three games. Mortellite shot 21-of-38 (55.3%) from the field, 11-of-21 (52.4%) from three-point range, and 11-of-11 from the foul line. He scored 29 points in the win over West Chester and 24 points in a victory at Millersville on January 10.

#### KACH ATTACK ...

Matthew Kachelries was named the PSAC East Freshman of the Week on Monday, November 27. Kachelries posted career-highs in points (18), steals (4), and blocked shots (3) as he helped the Huskies to an 86-67 victory over Holy Family on Tuesday, November 21, in the team's only game that week.

#### YOUTH MOVEMENT ...

The Huskies have three seniors and one junior this season and returned only four players from last year's team that finished 15-12. One of the three seniors - Hashim Moore - transferred in from Division I Princeton and is in his first season with the Huskies. Christian Mortellite and Kyle-Michael Rose are the other two seniors on the team while redshirt junior Darius Robinson-Wallace and redshirt sophomore Sam Saxton join the duo as the only other returners from last year's team. Redshirt freshman Peyton Mortellite was on last year's roster but did not play.

## HEAD COACH JOHN SANOW

John Sanow begins his 12th season as head coach of the men's basketball program at Bloomsburg in 2017-18. In his first 11 seasons with the Huskies, he has guided the program to a record of 133-163 and is second all-time in career wins in school history.

Over the last six seasons, the Huskies have made the PSAC tournament five times and earned a share of the PSAC Eastern Division regular season championship in 2011-12. Bloomsburg has gone 85-78 during the stretch.

Last year, the Huskies made the playoffs for the second year in a row only to bow out after an 84-77 setback to West Chester, at home, in the opening round of the tournament.

The highlight of the 2016-17 campaign was the play of Christian Mortellite. The sharpshooter was named to the All-PSAC Eastern Division First Team for the second year in a row after leading the country in three-pointers made per game (4.07). He was also honored as an NABC Second Team All-District - the first Husky to be recognized by the NABC since Dontahe Jordan in 2011-12. He led the Huskies in scoring (22.7), becoming the first Huskies' player since Tom Barlow, who averaged 20.3 points per game during the 2002-03 season, to average at least 20 points per game in a single campaign. Mortellite broke the single-season school record for points with 613 last year which broke the previous record of 600 set by Mike Elly during the 1996-97 season. He also shattered the school-record for most threes made in a season (110) and three-point attempts in a season (255).

In 2015-16, the Huskies returned to the PSAC playoffs after a one-year hiatus. Bloomsburg finished 17-10 overall and won 10 of its last 12 regular season games before suffering an 80-78 loss at Shippensburg in the opening round of the conference playoffs. The 17 victories marked the second-highest single-season total under Sanow's tutelage while the team's 15-7 mark in the PSAC East tied for the best conference mark with Sanow at the helm. Mortellite was an All-PSAC East First Team honoree.

Sanow helped guide the Huskies to three straight PSAC postseason appearances from 2012 to 2014 - the longest streak for the school since an eight-year run from 1995 to 2002. The Huskies earned the third seed from the Eastern Division in the 2013-14 PSAC playoffs and picked up a first round victory over Kutztown, ultimately finishing the season at 16-12 overall and 10-6 in conference play. It was Bloomsburg's first postseason win since the 2002 playoffs. Following the season, Dontahe Jordan was named First Team All-PSAC East while fellow senior Lorenzo Christmas earned a spot on the Second Team. Both players finished their careers with more than 1,000 points with Christmas owning the school's all-time record for made three-pointers and Jordan became one of only five players in BU history to reach both 1,000 points and 700 rebounds. He also coached Alssene Saintilus, who signed a contract to play professionally in Italy following the 2014-15 season.

Overall, Sanow has more than 25 years of experience with previous coaching stops at the University of Vermont along with Division II schools Gannon University and Pitt-Johnstown. He also spent 11 years as an assistant coach at Division I St. Francis of Pennsylvania.

Sanow was named PSAC East Coach of the Year in 2011-12 after leading the Huskies to 19 victories. That season, Sanow produced one of the best men's basketball seasons at Bloomsburg in recent memory. He led the Huskies to a 19-9 record, their best showing in

11 years, and a share of the PSAC Eastern crown. The Huskies also made a trip to the PSAC playoffs for the first time in 10 seasons and hosted their first home play-off game since the 1998-99 season. Sanow coached the PSAC Eastern Player of the Year in Dontahe Jordan, who also earned NABC All-District First Team honors and Daktronics Atlantic Region Second Team honors, as well as the PSAC Eastern Defensive Athlete of the Year in Larry Webster, who would later go on to play in the NFL with the Detroit Lions.

Sanow's players also reached career milestones in the 2011-12 season. Both Trevon Johnson and Webster scored their 1,000th career points under Sanow's tutelage. They were the first Bloomsburg players to reach the 1,000 point plateau in five years. In addition, Webster cemented his place among Bloomsburg greats by ending his career as Bloomsburg's all-time shot blocker with 175 career rejections.

In 2010-11, the Huskies narrowly missed out on reaching the PSAC playoffs losing out on the final game of the year. The Huskies seven PSAC Eastern Division wins were the most for the team since the 2000-01 season. Sanow also coached the PSAC Eastern Division Rookie of the Year in Dontahe Jordan. During the season Jordan was named the PSAC East Rookie of the Week seven times.

In 2009-10, the Huskies just missed out on the PSAC playoffs after dropping its final game of the season. Among the 12 wins for the Huskies was a 12-point victory over seventh-ranked Kutztown. Bloomsburg also lost several close games suffering four defeats in overtime.

In his first season with the Huskies in 2006-07, Sanow guided the Huskies to a mark of 13-14, an improvement of seven wins from the previous season and the first time since 2001-02 that the team reached double figures in wins. Sanow won his first six games as coach and had the team nationally ranked for the first time in several years. He also closed out the season winning four of the final five games and just missed out on a berth in the PSAC playoffs. Also, the eight wins the Huskies recorded at the Nelson Field House were the most since the team won 10 in 2000-01.

A native of Windber, Pa., who is well connected in basketball in the East, Sanow is a 1987 graduate of Indiana (Pa.) University. After transferring from Clarion University in 1984, he led IUP in scoring and was an All-PSAC First Team selection in 1986. He also set numerous three-point shooting records for the Indians.

At Vermont in 2005-06, he was part of a new coaching staff that led the least-experienced team in the nation in D-I (no seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and seven freshmen) to the America East Championship game for the fourth straight season. The sixth-seeded Catamounts (13-17, 7-9 America East) topped #3 Boston University and #2 Binghamton before falling at top-seeded Albany in the title game.

While at St. Francis (Pa.), he was an integral part of the Red Flash winning the 1991 Northeast Conference title and a trip to the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship. In 1992, he also was an assistant coach for the Panama Men's Olympic Team in its attempt to qualify for the Summer Olympics in Barcelona. While at St. Francis, he coached Mike Iuzzolino, who went on to play for the NBA's Dallas Mavericks.
