THE SERIES

The Huskies and Golden Eagles all-time series dates back to their first meeting in 1934 and Bloomsburg holds a 9-4-1 advantage over Clarion. The Huskies have won the last seven meetings, including two during the 2017 season. The Huskies are 5-2 against Clarion at home. The Huskies largest margin of victory came in 2007 when Bloomsburg defeated Clarion 52-10 at Clarion.

QUITE THE STREAK

Bloomsburg has scored at least one point in 208 consecutive games dating back to a 21-0 home loss against Shippensburg on September 13, 2003. Bloomsburg is 115-3 all-time when scoring at least 40 points in a game. However, the Huskies have only reached the 40-point plateau six times in the last 49 contests. The Huskies defeated Lock Haven 44-0 on Homecoming last year

I'LL TAKE THAT

The Huskies dominated the turnover battle against Stonehill and picked up right where they left off in 2021. Bloomsburg forced one fumble and recovered a pair of fumbles as Stonehill muffed a punt early in the second quarter that Deeko Kofa jumped on to get the ball back to the Huskies with a short field. The Huskies needed just 25 yards to get into end zone on a run by Zane Janiszewski and fumble recovery by John Ayres. Quentin Gaskill had his first pick of the season late in the fourth quarter as he intercepted a pass in the end zone by Stonehill.

The Huskies did not turn the ball over against Stonehill.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN(S)

The Huskies named a group of 10 leaders as captains for the 2022 season - Aaron Trumino, Tyshaun Pollard, Chris Monaco, Adam Burkhart, Jack Riley, Quentin Gaskill, Billy Martin, Ky Seesholtz, John Ayres, and Tom Goetz.

THE TOWN OF BROTHERLY LOVE

The Huskies boast a pair of brothers on their roster again this season. Senior Chris Monaco came back to make up for the lost season to due to COVID to join his brother, Kaleb, in Bloomsburg Maroon & Gold for the second-straight season. Sophomore quarter David LePoidevin welcomes his little brother, Patrick, to a strong group of signal callers for the Huskies this season.

The Monaco brothers were a dynamic pair for the Huskies last season. Kaleb is the leader of young group as a returning All-PSAC East Honoree. He burst on the scene for BU with 707 yards on the ground and 133 carries as an All-PSAC East Second Team running back. Kaleb had 372 yards on the kick return on 15 returns during the season. Chris returns for the Huskies after starting all 11 games for BU last year. Monaco made 48 tackles, including 2.0 TFL. He was responsible for four of the Huskies' interceptions and broke up nine passes.

FRESH OUTLOOK

The Huskies boast one of the youngest starting lineups in all of Division II college football. On opening day, Bloomsburg looks to start 18 freshmen or sophomores and have 38 underclassmen total listed on the depth chart. Under center, the Huskies' projected starter is freshman KJ Riley from Danville, Pa. Number two behind him is sophomore David LePoidevin, who played in 10 games last season and threw for 1,423 yards and 16 touchdowns.

Protecting the two QBs will be a mix of redshirt juniors, sophomores and freshmen. Marlon Wescott, Nelly Fain, and Aaron Bensinger look to bring leadership to the young group of o-linemen.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Coach Sheptock did not have to go far for talent to fill this year's roster. The 2022 Huskies boast 27 players from Columbia and surroundings counties. The Huskies have three players from local Danville Area High School and another from Southern Columbia and Berwick.

The local talent made an immediate impact on the field for the Huskies this past week as KJ Riley started under center for the Huskies against Stonehill while John Ayres scored a pair of touch downs - one fumble recovery and another rushing TD.

Jake Davis broke up a pass and had four solo tackles while Joseph Kahn had a pair of tackles including a sack for a loss of nine yards.

Kaleb Monaco led the team with 52 rushing yards and had 111 all purpose yards. Chris Monaco finished the day with four tackles and a broken up pass.

SHEPTOCK ERA

Sheptock was named the 28th head football coach in Bloomsburg University as he returns to his alma mater to take over the Huskies' program. Sheptock was at Division III Wilkes University as the defensive coordinator from 1990-95 and then took over the Colonels' program and served as head coach from 1996-2014. While at Wilkes, Sheptock went 107-81 overall and established the program record for most wins in a season (11) and career (107), while leading the Colonels to nine postseason appearances.

A member of the NCAA Division II Team of the Quarter Century (1973-97), Sheptock played linebacker for head coach George Landis and holds the school records for tackles in a career (537), single-season (159), and single-game (23), as well as career fumble recoveries (12). His program record for tackles in a single-game, in fact, occurred during the national semifinal contest at North Alabama.

HUDDLE WITH THE HUSKIES

For the second-straight year, head coach Frank Sheptock will host "Huddle with the Huskies" at Quaker Steak & Lube in Buckhorn, Pa. on three select Thursdays this season. The first "Huddle with the Huskies" is set for Thursday, September 15, ahead of the Huskies first road game of the season as they travel out west to Edinboro. The second Huddle with the Huskies is scheduled for October 20, just ahead of Bloomsburg's Homecoming match up with East Stroudsburg. The final Huddle will take place on November 3, just before the Huskies' final home game of the season against Millersville.

The events are open to the public with dinner beginning at 6:00 p.m. and a short program to follow. A buffet dinner will be held each night with the cost of the meal being \$14 per person - including a non-alcoholic beverage. Following the dinner, Coach Sheptock will speak about the season, preview the upcoming game(s), and introduce members of the coaching staff and players from this year's roster.

2022 PSAC PRESEASON POLL

LOCK HAVEN, Pa. - The Bloomsburg University football was selected to finish sixth in the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Eastern Division by the league's coaches in the 2022 Preseason Poll.

Last year's runner's up, Shepherd, was selected to win the East this year with four first-place votes, while the reigning PSAC champion, Kutztown, was chosen to finish second with four first-place votes. West Chester rounded out the top three. Shippensburg, East Stroudsburg, and Bloomsburg finished four, five, and six in the voting, while Millersville came in at No. 7 and Lock Haven at No. 8.

On the West, IUP and Slippery Rock grabbed three first-place votes each and a share of the top spot. California earned a pair of first-place votes and came in at number three on the poll. Gannon finished fourth in the voting while Edinboro and Seton Hill tied for the fifth spot. Mercyhurst came in at No. 7 while Clarion rounded the West at No. 8.

The Huskies finished the 2021 campaign 3-8 with a 2-5 record in PSAC East action under head coach Frank Sheptock. Bloomsburg defeated Gannon on a last-second touchdown pass in Sheptock's first home game of the season. The Huskies handed Lock Haven a 44-0 shutout on Homecoming for its first shutout since the 2015 season.

2022 KEY RETURNERS

Bloomsburg returns a pair of all-PSAC players in junior safety Quentin Gaskill (Waynesboro, Pa./Waynesboro) and sophomore running back Kaleb Monaco (Pocono Pines, Pa./Pocono Mountain West). Gaskill, a First Team All-PSAC East defensive back, led Bloomsburg with 89 tackles, including 53 solo. He paced BU with three forced fumbles and three recoveries while pulling down one of the team's 16 interceptions. Monaco burst on the scene for BU with 707 yards on the ground and 133 carries as an All-PSAC East Second Team running back. Monaco had 372 yards on the kick return on 15 returns during the season.

Junior David LePoidevin (Middlesex, N.J./Bound Brook) returns to lead a talented pack of returning and new quarterbacks for the Huskies. LePoidevin finished the year 106-for-189 with 16 TDs and 1,423 yards. Ben Ries (Bloomsburg, N.J./Phillipsburg) played nine games and went 32-for-63 with two TDs and 399 yards. Ries ran for 111 yards as well.

Graduate student Tyshaun Pollard (Harrisburg, Pa./Central Dauphin East) returns as a top target for the quarterbacks after finishing the 2021 season with 537 yards on 41 catches in all 11 games for the Huskies. Pollard caught four touch-down passes and had a season-long catch of 50 yards. He took care of the punt returns for the Huskies in 2021 and had three kickoff returns for 77 yards. Sophomore Nas Jones (Williamsport, Pa./Williamsport Area) looks to build on his first solid year with the program. Jones finished 2021 with 28 catches for 295 yards and three touchdowns as an h-back.

The Huskies' defense was one of the more prolific turnover defenses in the PSAC and Division II. Bloomsburg posted 28 takeaways, eighth in DII and first in the conference. Bloomsburg finished the year with 31 passes broken up, and 46 passes defended.

Joining Gaskill as a returner on the defensive unit is junior Adam Burkhardt (Harrisburg, Pa./Central Dauphin). Burkhardt played eight games for the Huskies in 2021 and made 59 tackles, including 1.0 tackles for loss and 0.5 sacks. Senior Chris Monaco (Pocono Pines, Pa./Pocono Mountain West) returns for the Huskies after starting all 11 games for BU last year. Monaco made 48 tackles, including 2.0 TFL. He was responsible for four of the Huskies' interceptions and broke up nine passes.

Redshirt sophomore Ky Seesholtz (Mifflinville, Pa./Central Columbia) started all 11 games last season and finished with 41 tackles, including 4.5 TFL and 2.0 sacks. He forced one fumble and had one quarterback hurry and one broken-up pass to his credit.

LAST TIME OUT - BU VS. STONEHILL

The Bloomsburg University football team battled for 60+ minutes against newly Division I Stonehill College Skyhawks but ultimately fell 33-30 in double overtime Saturday afternoon.

The Huskies used a balanced running game and took advantage of critical mistakes by the Skyhawks to nearly pull off the upset in the final scheduled meeting between the two teams.

Stonehill got on the board with a 24-yard field goal on their opening drive. The Skyhawks went 69 yards and used just over seven minutes of gameplay but had to settle for a chip-shot field goal to take a 3-0 lead in the first quarter.

After the Huskies had to punt from their 48-yard line, the Bloomsburg defense forced a three-and-out, and the Huskies took over at their 20-yard line. The Huskies marched down the field and used eight and a half minutes of game time that took the game into the second quarter. Freshman Brendan McGonigle (Ocean City, N.J./Ocean City) capped the drive with a 22-yard field goal to tie the game at 3-3 with 11:19 to play in the quarter.

The Skyhawks fumbled the ensuing kickoff, and Deeko Kofa (Philadelphia, Pa./Samuel Fels) recovered the loose ball at the Stonehill-25 to set up a short field for the Huskies. Bloomsburg took full advantage of the excellent field position to punch into the endzone for its first lead. Zane Janiszewski (Hollisterville, Pa./Western Wayne) carried the ball eight yards before John Mack (Minisink Valley, N.Y./Minisink Valley) caught a 15-yard pass from KJ Riley (Danville, Pa./Danville Area) to get down to the two-yard line. Facing 1st and Goal from the two, the Huskies returned to Janiszewski to push into the endzone. The sophomore running back got into the endzone, but the ball came loose as he crossed the plane, and John Ayres (Mt. Carmel, Pa./Mt. Carmel) jumped on it to recover the fumble for a touchdown, his first game. McGonigle connected on the extra point, and the Huskies took a 10-3 lead early in the second quarter.

Stonehill's next drive ended with another shot field goal thanks to another defensive stop by the Huskies. Stonehill looked poised to get into the endzone as the Skyhawks faced a 1st-and-10 from the Bloomsburg 11, but after a six-yard run on second down, Ron Long (Philadelphia, Pa./Archbishop Ryan) broke up Ashur Carraha's next pass on third down to force a field goal on 4th-and-4 from the Bloomsburg 5-yard line. Perry Sheldred's kick was good, and the Skyhawks cut the Bloomsburg lead to 10-6.

The Huskies' third possession of the second quarter ended in another punt, but Bloomsburg got the ball right back after the Skyhawks muffed the punt, and Ayres recovered the fumble at the Stonehill-11 to give the Huskies a short distance to get into the endzone.

Once again, the Huskies capitalized on the Skyhawks' mistake and needed just three plays to get into the endzone. Janiszewski rushed for two yards before Riley connected with Owen Anderson (Cogan Station, Pa./Jersey Shore Area) for eight yards and a Huskies' first down. Janiszewski was called on again to push the pile forward from the 1-yard line, and after another McGonigle extra point, the Huskies led 17-6 with 1:21 to play in the half.

The Skyhawks used all of that 1:21 to close out the half and found their way into the endzone for the first time in the game, and the Huskies carried a 17-13 lead into halftime.

Bloomsburg received the kick to open the second half and went 3-and-out before the Skyhawks marched down the field after starting at their own 18. The Skyhawks had a 2nd-and-5 from the Bloomsburg-20, and Joseph Kahn (Selinsgrove, Pa./Selinsgrove) picked up the first sack of the year, a nine-yard loss, to push the Skyhawks back. Stonehill got nine yards back on the next play but couldn't move the chains and had to settle for another field goal.

Leading by one, 17-16, with 6:50 to play in the third, the Huskies began their drive on their 35-yard line. Jerry Griffen-Batchler opened the drive with a 16-yard scramble down the near sideline to get into Stonehill territory. Kaleb Monaco (Pocono Pines, Pa./Pocono Mountain West) followed up with a 13-yard run of his own to get down to the 36-yard line. The Huskies chipped away at the clock and yardage with nine-straight runs, including a 10-yard scramble by Riley and a four-yard touchdown run for Ayres on 3rd-and-1 from the four-yard line.

The Huskies forced a three-and-out on the next Skyhawks drive, and McGonigle hit another field goal, this time a 44-yard attempt from the 34-yard line, and the Huskies led 27-16.

Stonehill looked poised to cut into the lead on its next drive, but Carraha threw into the endzone on 2nd-and-15 from the Bloom-15 and, instead of finding a teammate in a white jersey, found Quentin Gaskill (Waynesboro, Pa./Waynesboro) waiting for the pass and grabbed his first interception of the season.

The Skyhawks scored on their next two drives and needed a 31-yard field goal with 13 seconds left on the clock to send the game into overtime.

Riley knelt for the final regulation play, and the Huskies headed into overtime.

Bloomsburg won the toss and elected to defend first. The Huskies kept the Skyhawks out of the endzone on their first possession, and Shelbred missed his field goal attempt to keep the game tied.

The Huskies struggled to move the ball forward on their overtime possession, and the two teams headed into a second overtime.

Getting the ball first, a pair of short runs by Tyshaun Pollard (Harrisburg, Pa./Central Dauphin East) sandwiched around a four-yard run from Janiszewski got the Huskies down to the four-yard line. McGonigle knocked a 33-yard field goal attempt through, and the Huskies took a 30-27 lead.

The Skyhawks relied on Jarel Washington to run the ball, carrying it six times, including a two-yard run to give Stonehill the 33-30 win.

Monaco carried the ball 19 times for 52 yards, while Ayres had a pair of touchdowns on the ground. Riley went 7-for-12 for 48 yards in the air and rushed for another 38.

Gaskill led the Huskies with 12 tackles, including a pair of sacks for 23 yards. Gaskill forced a fumble, had one interception, and broke up three passes.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE GOLDEN EAGLES - NOVEMBER 11, 2017

The Bloomsburg University football team scored 31 consecutive points after falling behind, 7-0, early and wrapped up the 2017 season with a 31-15 victory over visiting Clarion University on a cold Saturday afternoon at Danny Hale Field at Redman Stadium. The Huskies conclude the year with a 7-4 record while the Golden Eagles finish with a 1-10 overall mark.

Redshirt senior Chris Palubinsky (Ringtown, Pa./Shenandoah Valley) finished off his collegiate career with a career-high three touchdown passes - two to redshirt sophomore Michael Allen (Oley, Pa./Oley Valley) - to pace the Huskies' offense. His other touchdown strike ended up in the hands of senior tight end Aaron Allison (Philadelphia, Pa./Frankford). Redshirt sophomore Qmac Quiteh (Tobyhanna, Pa./Pocono Mountain West) finished with 75 rushing yards and the other Huskies' score but closed out the season just 21 yards shy of reaching 1,000 yards for the season.

Defensively, redshirt junior Jake Klinger (Berwick, Pa./Central Columbia) added to his case for the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Eastern Division Defensive Player of the Year honor by tormenting Clarion quarterback Jeff Clemens and the Golden Eagle offensive line all game. He finished the afternoon with nine tackles, four tackles for a loss, and two sacks. He also forced and recovered a fumble late in the third quarter which led to Quiteh's 14-yard touchdown run, and the final points of the afternoon for the Huskies. Klinger wraps up the season as the team leader in tackles (69), tackles for a loss (22.0), and quarterback sacks (11.0). His 22 tackles for a loss surpassed Justin Shirk's 21.5 tackles behind the line of scrimmage during the 2014 season and is the most by a Bloomsburg player in at least 18 years.

The Golden Eagles started the scoring when Clemens found Cameron Jefferies on a screen pass that covered 44 yards for the first touchdown of the game with 6:01 left in the opening quarter. James Metzgar added the extra point to give the visitors a 7-0 advantage. However, on the ensuing Bloomsburg possession, redshirt junior Ryan Abbott (Hagerstown, Md./Saint James School), playing in his final collegiate game, booted a career-long 42-yard field goal to cap off an 11-play, 47-yard drive that took 5:39 off the clock and, with 13 seconds left in the opening quarter, the Huskies found themselves trailing 7-3.

After a three-and-out by Clarion, the Huskies were given excellent field position at the Clarion 44 yard line after just a ten-yard punt from Metzgar. Bloomsburg took advantage as the hosts drove 44 yards on seven plays capped off by a 30-yard touchdown pass from Palubinsky to Allen and, after Abbott drilled the extra point, the Huskies had their first lead of the game at 10-7 with 10:21 left in the first half. Then, after another three-and-out by the Golden Eagle offense, Bloomsburg put together another touchdown-scoring drive - this time on nine plays and 53 yards - with Palubinsky finding Allison on a 23-yard strike with 3:26 left in the first half. Abbott hit the extra point to extend the Bloomsburg lead to 17-7.

The Huskies, after deferring the opening coin toss, got the ball to start the second half and on the first possession of the third quarter, Palubinsky found Allen for a 36-yard touchdown pass on fourth-and-13 to extend the lead to 24-7 after Abbott hit the point after. The redshirt senior threw deep into the right corner of the endzone on a jump-ball situation and Allen outjumped and ripped the ball out of the hands of a Clarion defender for his second touchdown reception of the day. It was the first time in Allen's career that he had caught more than one touchdown in a single game.

Bloomsburg added another score later in the quarter after Klinger's strip sack gave the Huskies the ball at the Clarion 14. Quiteh took the handoff on the first play from scrimmage and powered his way across the goal line for his eighth rushing score of the season. Abbott nailed the extra point and the Huskies saw their lead balloon to 31-7 with 2:55 left in the third.

Clarion answered on its next drive when Clemens found Marcus McCoy on a 36-yard touchdown pass with 55 seconds left in the third quarter. Clemens then hit Mylique McGriff for the two-point conversion to cut the lead to 31-15.

The Golden Eagles had another chance to pull closer late in the fourth quarter but senior Darnell Baldwin (Philadelphia, Pa./Lankenau) picked off Clemens in the endzone with 3:43 left and the Huskies ran out the clock on the ensuing possession to secure the victory. Bloomsburg sealed the win by converting on third-and-seven on a 12-yard strike from Palubinsky to redshirt sophomore Jay Popson (Mountain Top, Pa./Crestwood) and then, later, on a two-yard plunge by Palubinsky on fourth-and-one during the final drive.

Both Clarion and Bloomsburg ran 60 plays and accumulated 299 yards of total offense on Saturday afternoon. The Huskies outgained the Golden Eagles, 138-52 on the ground with Clarion holding the edge in passing yards, 247-161.

Quiteh led the Huskies' ground game with 75 yards and a score on 21 carries. He finished the season with 799 yards rushing - 21 yards shy of extending Bloomsburg's streak of consecutive seasons with a 1,000-yard back. The streak ends at seven. Redshirt sophomore Alex Gooden (Parkesburg, Pa./Octorara) carried the ball ten times for 43 yards. Palubinsky finished 11-of-20 for 161 yards and a career-high three touchdowns. Allen caught five passes for a career-high 94 yards and a career-best two scores. Allison finished with three catches for 45 yards and the other score.

McGriff led Clarion with 84 rushing yards on 20 carries. Clemens finished 16-of-29 for 247 yards and two touchdowns but the big pick in the endzone late in the fourth quarter. Devin Clark caught a team-high four passes for 47 yards while McGriff had a team-high 71 receiving yards on three receptions.

In addition to Klinger's monster game (nine tackles, four tackles for a loss, two sacks, one forced fumble, and one fumble recovery), senior Osman Toure (Philadelphia, Pa./Academy Park) and redshirt sophomore Alex Annan (Phillipsburg, N.J./Phillipsburg) also chipped in with nine total stops. It marked a career-high for Toure in his final collegiate game. Senior Eric Schwartz (York, Pa./Central York) finished with five tackles while redshirt freshman Alex Findura (Bloomsburg, Pa./Woodland (Ga.)) collected his first career sack on Veterans' Day. Both Schwartz and Findura had a fitting end to the season as they both served four years in the United States Marine Corps.
