The Huskies come into Saturday's game after a convincing 35-7 win over Fairmont State last Thursday night. It was the first time since 2018 the Huskies opened the year with a victory. In 2018, Bloomsburg defeated Merrimack College 30-16 at home to kick off a 6-5 campaign. Seton Hill comes into the game 0-2 on the young season after falling to Fairmont State 56-24 to open the year and dropping a 21-14 decision to Ohio Dominican University last week.

The Huskies and Griffins meet for just the third time in program history, despite sharing a conference affiliation. The all-time series is tied 1-1 with each team defending its home turf for a win. The last time the Huskies welcome Seton Hill to Bloomsburg, they came away with a 17-14 win in 2015. Redshirt junior Tyler Smith kicked the game-winning field goal as time expired to give the Huskies the win in the regular season finale.

SCOUTING SETON HILL

The Griffins are 0-2 on the young season but have a strong stable of offensive players on display. Leading the run for Seton Hill is redshirt junior Ky'Ron Craggette, who has racked up 199 yards on the ground on 44 carries in two games. Craggette is averaging 99.5 yards a game and 4.5 yards a carry this year and has a pair of rushing touchdowns. He has a long run of 35 yards and eclipsed the 100-yard rushing marking against Ohio Dominican with 104 yards on 20 carries and a TD. Craggette is doing it all for the Griffins as he has 41 receiving yards on three catches as well.

Ethan Fame is the top receiver for the Griffins with 10 catches and 159 yards, averaging 79.5 yards per game and 15.9 yards per catch. He has two receiving touchdowns this year and a long catch of 63 yards. Todd Phillips has made the most of his receptions as he has 94 receiving yards on just three catches and averages 31.33 yards per catch, with a long of 37. Taiyon Battle has three catches as well for 28 yards.

Jake Cruz has played every offensive snap under center for the Griffins this year and is 28-for-52 with two interceptions thrown. He has two touchdowns and 386 yards in the air, averaging 193.00 yards per game this year and a season quarterback rating of 121.20.

The Griffin offense is averaging 329.5 yards per game, including 136.5 yards on the ground and 193.0 yards passing this season. The Griffins have scored five touchdowns. Seton Hill is 3-for-6 (50.0%) on fourth down tries and 8-for-29 (27.59%) on third down conversions.

Jack Wagner is 1-for-4 on field goal attempts this year, hitting a 41-varder against Fairmont State to open the year.

Defensively, the Griffins are led by Ritchie McCormack with 12 tackles, 1.0 TFL (3 yards). David Awuah has 11 tackles and D'Kairi Boone and Jordan Dorman each have 10 tackles to their credit. Boone broke up one pass so far this year. Quinton Possey is responsible for the sole Griffin interception and Ben Weaver has a quarterback hurry.

As a team, the Griffins are allowing 413.0 yards on offense to opposing teams, including 133.0 rushing yards and 280.0 yards in the air. They have given up six passing touchdowns and five rushing touchdowns and 38.5 points per game through the first two games. Opposing offenses are averaging 6.2 yards per play against the Seton Hill defense

SCOUTING THE HUSKIES

The Huskies have a strong mix of experienced leadership and young talent coming into the 2024 campaign, and it was on display in the Huskies 35-7 win over Fairmont State last Thursday. Graduate student quarterback Ben Ries led the offense to five total touchdowns, two in the air and three rushing - one of which was a 15-yard run himself. Ries went 12-for-18 with one interception and 182 yards in his season debut with a quarterback rating of 177.16.

Ries' top-target from 2023 returned as a favorite receiver as Jerry Griffen-Batchler caught four passes for 80 yards and a pair of touchdowns. Matthew Bowes returned from an injury that sidelined him through all of the 2023 season a caught a pass for 45 yards. Justin Wolfe caught five passes for 51 yards and Gabe Brower caught two for six yards.

The run game displayed a healthy stable of young backs ready to make a name for themselves in the maroon and gold. Sophomore Matt Buchman ran for a career-best 94 yards on 15 carries and got into the end zone once while freshman Jake Williams carried the ball 14 times for 52 yards. Freshman Riley Parker carried the ball twice for 39 yards, including a 39-yard run for his first touchdown as a Husky. Redshirt freshman Isaiah Megginson ran the ball five times for 22 yards while senior Gabe Brower carried the ball four times for 34 yards.

As a team, the Huskies ran 73 plays on offense and accumulated 466 total yards of offense. Bloomsburg averaged 6.4 yards per play against Fairmont State last Thursday and scored five total touchdowns. The Huskies run game went for 284 net yards, only losing 18 yards on 55 total attempts.

Defensively, Brady Thompson totaled eight tackles last week, including 0.5 TFL (3 yards). Nate Capers showed out with seven tackles, two pass break ups and a quarterback hurry. Ryan D'Ambra had seven total tackles as well. Cole Turner finished the day with five tackles and a pass breakup. Charles Crews III and Ian Donohue combined for a sack (loss of eight yards) and the pair had three tackles each.

The Husky defense allowed just 239 yards of total offense on 52 plays. Bloomsburg limited the Falcons to 62 yards on the ground and 177 passing yards and just one touchdown. Fairmont State was 3-for-11 (27.27%) on third down conversions and 0-3 on fourth down tries.

ON THIS DAY - SEPTEMBER 14

Bloomsburg Football History, September 14, 2013

It was a day for history under clear blue skies at Sox Harrison Stadium on Saturday afternoon as Franklyn Quiteh (Tobyhanna/Pocono Mountain West) and Danny Fisher (Liverpool/Central Dauphin) each re-wrote the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference record books as part of the 15th-ranked Huskies' 47-35 victory over the Fighting Scots.

With an eight yard carry early in the fourth quarter, Quiteh surpassed the previous all-time PSAC career rushing record of 5,689 held by Bloomsburg product Jamar Brittingham since 2007. Quiteh's moment with history wasn't the first of the day, however. Earlier in the afternoon, Fisher set his own PSAC record, breaking the conference mark for kicking points in a career of 287 which Mark Brubaker of East Stroudsburg had owned since 2005, now standing at 291. He also connected on two field goals to tie the record of 50 set by Ed Detwiler of East Stroudsburg in 1992.

Quiteh finished the day with 231 yards rushing to push his career total to 5,741 in maroon and gold. The senior found the endzone three times on the day as well.

MCGONIGLE RETURNS

Brendan McGonigle returns to do the place kicking for the Huskies after an injury shortened his 2023 campaign. McGonigle is 13-for-18 in his career in field goals and 31-33 in point after attempts. McGonigle has a career-long field goal 47 yards, which he hit against Millersville on 11/05/22.

This season, McGonigle is a perfect 5-for-5 on point after attempts and has not attempting a field goal yet.

PROTECTING THE QE

The offensive line was a bright spot for the Huskies in 2023. The Bloomsburg o-line allowed the fewest sacks of all the PSAC schools, letting the quarterback get sacked just 12 times in 12 games and giving back just 87 yards on the sacks. This season, the Huskies gave up just one sack against Fairmont State, but helped the rushing game to 284 yards on the ground.

PLAYING A CLEAN GAME

The Huskies were the second-least penalized team in the PSAC last season. Bloomsburg was called for just 55 penalties which cost the Huskies just 522 yards, averaging just 43.5 yards per game. The least-penalized team was Kutztown with 53 flags for 453 yards and the most penalized team was Seton Hill which drew 112 flags for 1,027 yards.

This season, Bloomsburg put up a near-spotless game for its first of the year. The Huskies were called for just four penalties and gave up 45 yards and just two penalty first downs

LET'S GO FOR IT

The Huskies went for it on 4th-down 16 times last season, converting nine of those attempts at a 56.3% clip. They were the fourth-best fourth-down conversion team in the PSAC last season behind California (Pa.) (8-13/61.5%), Slippery Rock (20-33/60.6%), and Edinboro (10-17/58.8). So far in 2024, the Huskies are just 0-1 on first downs, but was 10-for-14 on third down tries last week, which eliminated the need for fourth down tries.

I'M HONORED

Junior Jerry Griffen-Batchler earned the Huskies' first PSAC East Athlete of the Week honor as he was named the PSAC East Special Teams player of the Week after his Week 1 performance. He returned four punts for 70 yards and set the Huskies' up with short fields each time he returned the ball. The 70 punt return yards was a career single-game high for Griffen-Batchler. He finished the game with 150 all-purpose yards after pulling down four catches for 80 yards and two touchdowns.

RIES' PIECES

Graduate student Ben Ries has a full complement of seasoned receivers at his disposal this season. All-conference tight end Matthew Bowes is back for the Huskies after a season-ending injury in 2022 kept him out of the 2023 season.

The Huskies top target of the quarterbacks last season, Jerry Griffen-Batchler, is back to stretch the field for Bloomsburg. Griffen-Batchler had 45 catches for 606 yards last season, averaging 13.47 yards per catch and 55.09 yards per game. He had a career-long catch of 56 yards against Lock Haven last year.

Owen Anderson hauled in 24 catches for 244 yards last year and averaged 10.17 yards per catch and Jaden Helton made five catches in three games for 86 yards, including a career-long 43 yard catch against East Stroudsburg.

THE RIES FILE

Ben Ries took over under center last season and finished out the year strong for the Huskies. In eight games, he went 68-for-125 with one touchdown and three interceptions. He threw for 747 yards, averaging 11.0 yards per play and 93.4 yards per game. Ries ran for another 97 yards on 47 attempts and two touchdowns. For his career, Ries is 101-for-192 with three touchdowns and seven interceptions and 1,146 yards. Ries has 284 yards on the ground on 94 rushing attempts in three seasons with the Huskies.

This season, Ries is 12-for-18 with 182 passing yards and two touchdowns. Ries has run for another 20 yards and a touchdown so far in 2024.

NO FLY ZONE

The Bloomsburg defensive backs made a statement last year and allowed the fewest passing yards to opponents in the PSAC and were ranked 11th in NCAA DII. The Huskies allowed just 152.55 yards per game to opposing quarterbacks and collected 10 interceptions. The longest passing play the Huskies allowed last season was just 39 yards. In total, Bloomsburg had 31 broken up passes for the year and hurried the quarterback 27 times.

Returning in the secondary for Bloomsburg is Ron Long (44 tackles, 2 INT, 1 QBH), Ervin Mitchell (6 tackles, 1 INT, 1 PBU), Devin Fleming (34 tackles, 4 PBU), and Nate Capers (39 tackles, 2 PBU, 2 QBH).

Capers showed off again in the first game of the season with seven tackles, a pair of pass break ups and a quarterback hurry. Taking on a bigger role in the secondary is Cole Turner who turned in five tackle and a pass break up against Fairmont State. Freshman Idriz Ahmetovic had a pass break up as well in his Husky debut.

STIFLE THE RUN

Fairmont State came into last Thursday's game with 208 yards on the ground in their week 0 game and five touchdowns. Bloomsburg brought the boom and stopped the Falcons run game, allowing just 62 yards on the ground and no touchdowns. The Falcons had 80 yards on 20 carries but the Huskies had 2.0 TFL for 18 yards.

LBU

The Huskies' linebackers have been a force to be reckoned with since the Frank Sheptock days, and the 2024 group is no different. Leading the way are seniors Ryan D'Ambra and Tom Goetz. D'Ambra led the Huskies with 90 total tackles last season and have 5.0 tackles for loss (19 yards) and 2.0 sacks (15 yards). He hit the quarterback four other times and blocked one kick. D'Ambra broke up four passes as well. D'Ambra has 160 tackles in his career so far.

Goetz, an all-PSAC linebacker, was third on the team with 76 tackles, including 3.0 tackles for loss (9 yards). He had two interceptions, one broken up pass, and three quarterback hurries. For his career, Goetz has 139 tackles in 26 games over the last three seasons. His 2022 season was shortened by an early-season injury. Goetz has 14 TFL (55 yards) and 6.5 sacks (38 yards).

Brady Thompson made his presence known in his first season with the Huskies last year. He had 67 tackles, including 5.0 tackles for loss (11 yards) and 0.5 sacks (2 yards). Thompson had three quarterback hurries to his credit and once forced fumble.

The Huskies brought in seven new linebackers in their 2024 recruiting class to continue the tradition – Nick Farrell, Garrett Garcia, Brady Ronan, Connor Rickabaugh, Brady Mizenko, Nahzier Booker, and Rocco Serafini.

Thompson and D'Ambra made their presence known with 15 tackles between the two of them and 0.5 TFL (3 yards).

TUCKER HONORED BY THE GIANTS

Former All-Pro tight end Bob Tucker, a one-time Mountaineer and Bloomsburg State College football player, went undrafted and played semi-pro football before the Giants signed him as a free agent ahead of the 1970 season.

One year later, the 6-foot-3, 230-pounder became the first tight end in NFL history to lead the league in pass receptions in a season with 59 for 791 yards. Through 1977, Tucker also had seasons with 55, 50, 42, 41 and 40 catches on Giants teams that often found themselves looking up at the Dallas Cowboys, Washington Redskins and even the St. Louis Cardinals in the rugged NFC East.

In 1978, he was traded to the Minnesota Vikings, where he was reunited with his former Giants teammate, Hall of Fame quarterback Fran Tarkenton. Tucker spent a few seasons with the Vikings before retiring in 1980 and ultimately returning to Hazleton.

Tucker finished his 11-year NFL career 422 receptions for 5,421 yards and 27 touchdowns.

Giants are set to honor Tucker as 43rd best player in team history.

Bloomsburg added 36 newcomers to the program on National Signing Day including six defensive backs, three defensive linemen, seven linebackers, a long snapper, five offensive linemen, a kicker, four quarterbacks, three running backs, two tight ends, and four wide receivers. The Huskies brought in players from two different states, including Pennsylvania (28), and New Jersey (8). The Huskies welcome four transfers to the roster this season. Spencer Branin from Southern Connecticut State, Ben Paserk from Lackawanna, Infinite Campbell from Lock Haven, and Malik McLaurin from Monroe.

The Huskies host West Chester on September 28 for the Salute to Danny Hale, sponsored by the Husky Legacy Club. Bloomsburg hosts East Stroudsburg on October 12 for the Homecoming/Hall of Fame and Parents' and Supporters Weekend. The game on October 26 against Shippensburg will serve as the Huskies' ThinkPink game. Bloomsburg will honor its football, band, and cheerleading senior student-athletes prior to the game against Millersville on November 9.

Ron Long, Ben Ries, Ky Seesholtz, Matthew Bowes, Nyree Ford-Cherry, Devin Fleming, Hakeem Bacon, Jaden Helton, Darnell Hightower, Nate Capers, Blake Charlton, Owen Anderson, Peyton Persing, Ryan D'Ambra, Neurys Ortiz, Jack Ferguson, Xavier Newman, Marlon Westcott, Tom Goetz, Rahmayne Jackson-Bey, and Giovanni Cancro line up for the Huskies for their final season at Bloomsburg.

SHEPTOCK ERA

Sheptock was named the 28th head football coach in Bloomsburg University as he

first win of the season before handing Shepherd a 14-10 loss in at Redman Stadium. The Huskies defeated Millersville 34-31 on the road in their final road trip of the year.

QUICK RECAP - 2023 GRIFFINS

The Griffins went 6-5 last season after starting the year 1-4. Seton Hill suffered a season-opening loss to Wheeling, 35-24, but earned a 28-23 win over Shippensburg to even out their record. The Griffins suffered three-straight losses to East Stroudsburg (55-21), Slippery Rock (35-14), and Gannon (23-6), before defeating Clarion 24-17. After a 41-14 loss to California (Pa.), the Griffins won four-straight to end the year. A 35-28 win over IUP kicked off the run before Seton Hill defeated Edinboro (38-28), Mercyhurst (14-0), and Millersville (30-10) to end the year on a high note.

COACHING STAFF UPDATES

Head coach Frank Sheptock has announced several updates to his staff ahead of the 2024 season. The Huskies welcomed Tim Landis, offensive coordinator, to Bloomsburg ahead of spring practice while Zach Martin (defensive coordinator & linebackers), Greg Kahn (defensive line), and Johnathan Pruden (defensive backs) joined the Huskies this summer. Previous student assistant Josh Bernocco was elevated to wide receivers coach and special teams coordinator following spring practices.

KEY LOSSES

The Huskies will take the field on Thursday without all-conference running back Kaleb Monaco. Monaco led the team with 952 yards on the ground last season and ran in six touchdowns. He averaged 5.1 yards per carry and 86.55 yards per game. Monaco had 1,658 all-purpose yards for the year.

Star defensive back Quentin Gaskill graduated last fall after a stellar career for the Huskies. Last season, he was second on the team with 76 tackles and had six broken up passes, two interceptions, and a blocked kick. For his career, Gaskill accumulated 279 tackles, 10.5 TLF (47 yards), 3.0 sacks (27 yards), six interceptions, 28 passes defended, five forced fumbles (three recoveries), and three blocked kicks. Gaskill played in 43 out of 44 possible games during his time in the maroon and gold.

RETURNING ALL-PSAC ATHLETES

The Huskies return a pair of all-PSAC players in senior linebacker Tom Goetz (Wenonah, N.J./Gateway Regional) and senior defensive lineman Giovanni Cancro (Pequannock, N.J./Pequannock Township). Cancro earned his first career postseason honor as a second-team defensive lineman. The Pequannock, N.J. native had a breakout year for the Huskies with 29 total tackles this year, including 15 solo stops. He had 5.0 tackles for a loss of 22 yards and broke up two passes. Cancro finished with one quarterback hurry and a blocked kick.

Goetz had an exceptional comeback season for the Huskies in 2023 after playing in just four games before a season-ending injuring in 2022. Goetz had a career-best 76 tackles, 9.5 tackles for loss (34 yards), and 4.5 sacks (23 yards). The Wenonah, N.J. native had a pair of interceptions and three pass breakups for the year. Both of his INTs came against Clarion – one that was recovered for a touchdown and the second to seal the win for the Huskies late in the fourth quarter. He led the team in tackles for loss and sacks.

returns to his alma mater to take over the Huskies' program. Sheptock was at Division III Wilkes University as the defensive coordinator from 1990-95 and then took over the Colonels program and served as head coach from 1996-2014. While at Wilkes, Sheptock went 107-81 overall and established the program record for most wins in a season (11) and career (107) while leading the Colonels to nine postseason appearances.

A member of the NCAA Division II Team of the Quarter Century (1973-97), Sheptock played linebacker for head coach George Landis and holds the school records for tackles in a career (537), single-season (159), and single-game (23), as well as career fumble recoveries (12). His program record for tackles in a single game, in fact, occurred during the national semifinal contest at North Alabama.

SALUTE TO DANNY HALE

NCAA DII football coaching legend of the Bloomsburg Huskies, Danny Hale, has gotten the call for his rightful enshrinement in the College Football Hall of Fame as part of the 2024 Induction Class, as announced by the National Football Foundation (NFF) and ESPN on in January of 2024. The Bloomsburg department of athletics in partnership with the Husky Legacy Club has announced the Salute to Danny Hale to celebrate his induction in Bloomsburg on September 28, 2024.

Hale, one of the winningest coaches in all of NCAA Division II, retired June 28, 2013, after spending 20 seasons as the head coach of the Huskies and 25 years overall as a head coach. Hale also spent five years

as head coach at West Chester University (1984-1988).

GREENSBURG, Pa. – The Bloomsburg University football team (0-2) was edged out, 13-7, on the road tonight at Seton Hill University (2-0) in a Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) East-West crossover.

The two teams were tied 7-7 at halftime and the Huskies' defensive unit recorded three interceptions for the game, but in the end, two second-half field goals proved to be the difference for the host-Griffins.

After a scoreless first quarter, Seton Hill went up 7-0 after a 4-yard touchdown run from Jaiquawn McGriff. The score came with 12:15 left in the second quarter and capped a 5-play, 43-yard drive.

Bloomsburg tied the game with 6:03 left in the half after a quick strike from freshman quarterback David LePoidevin (Middlesex, N.J./Bound Brook) (Selinsgrove, Pa./Selinsgrove) to redshirt-sophomore John Ayres (Mt. LAST TIME OUT - BLOOM vs Fairmont State (September 5, 2024)

The Huskies dominated every phase of the game as Bloomsburg football opened the season with a 35-7 win over Fairmont State, Thursday night. The Huskies debuted their new black uniforms and showed off in front of a home crowd under the lights. Bloomsburg ran for 284 yards and found the end zone five times in the victory.

Graduate student Ben Ries (Bloomsbury, N.J./Phillipsburg) led his offense with a 12-for-18 day passing for 182 yards and two touchdowns. He ran for another 20 yards on nine carries and one touchdown. Ries found Jerry Griffen-Batchler (Norristown, Pa./Germantown Academy) four times, two of the catches were in the end zone, for 80 yards. Justin Wolfe (Hollidaysburg, Pa./Hollidaysburg Area) hauled in five passes for 51 yards while Matthew Bowes (Somerton, Pa./La Salle College HS) caught a pass for 45 yards. Gabe Brower (Alexandria, Pa./Juniata Valley) caught two passes for six yards.

The run game stole the show as the Huskies ran for 284 yards on 55 attempts and scored three times. Matt Buchman (Hazleton, Pa./Hazleton) led the way with a career day of 94 yards on 15 carries and one touchdown. Jake Williams (Myerstown, Pa./ELCO) got the ball 14 times in his Bloomsburg debut for 52 yards and Parker Riley ran for 39 yards on two carries and a touchdown. Brower had four carries for 34 yards and Isaiah Megginson (Edgewood, Md./Edgewood) had five carries and 22 yards. KJ Riley (Danville, Pa./Danville Area) ran for 21 yards.

Griffen-Batchler did it all for the Huskies as he returned four punts for a career-best 70 yards and finished the day with 150 all-purpose yards.

The Bloomsburg offense had the ball for 41:06 minutes.

The Huskies and Falcons traded punts on the first two drives before the Huskies gave up a fumble on their second drive of the game. Bloomsburg got the ball right back, though, as the Huskies forced the Falcons to go for it on 4th-and-1 at the Bloomsburg 40. Leonard Farrow's rush attempt was met with Ian Donohue (Schuylkill Haven, Pa./Blue Mountain) and Brady Thompson (Green Lane, Pa./Upper Perkiomen) coming up the middle for a seven-yard loss and a turnover on downs.

Bloomsburg took over at its 47-yard line with 4:50 to play in the first. A nine-yard pass from Ries to Brower on 2nd-and-10 flipped the field for the Huskies and Buchman ripped off a 15-yard run to get down to the FSU-29. Ries from Wolfe on 3rd-and-8 for eight yards and a first down before Buchman got the Huskies down to the 15-yard line on a four-yard run. Ries took the ball himself on the next play and hurried down the near sideline for a 15-yard touchdown run and a 6-0 Bloomsburg lead. Brendan McGonigle (Ocean City, N.J./Ocean City) hit the extra point attempt, and Bloomsburg pushed its lead to 7-0 with 35 seconds to go in the quarter.

After forcing another 3-and-out by the Falcons on their next drive, the Huskies marched down the field again for a 15-play, 70-yard scoring drive that took 7:55 off the clock. The longest play of the drive came on an 11-yard catch by Griffen-Batchler and the drive was capped by a 1-yard run by Buchman into the end zone on 3rd-and-goal from the one-yard line. McGonigle was perfect on his extra point attempt and Bloomsburg took a 14-0 lead with 6:42 remaining in the half.

Fairmont State answered with its only scoring drive of the game as the Falcons went 67 yards on six plays and only used 2:11 to cut the lead in half, 14-7.

After the two teams traded scoreless drives, the Huskies found the end zone once more before the break.

The Huskies took over at midfield after forcing the Falcons to go for it on fourth down with 39 seconds to go before halftime. Buchman set the Huskies up with a 33-yard run down the sideline to get Bloomsburg down to the FSU 17-yard line. After a Husky timeout, Ries found Griffen-Batchler for his first touchdown, a 17-yard pass with 11 seconds to play. McGoniqle hit the extra point and gave Bloomsburg a 21-7 lead.

Fairmont State received the kickoff to start the second half but the Huskies forced another punt and Griffen-Batchler got Bloomsburg up to the BLOOM-45 for their first drive of the half. The Huskies had one of their quickest scoring drive of the game, needing only three plays to go 55 yards into the end zone. Williams carried the ball twice for 21 yards to open the drive before Ries again found Griffen-Batchler. This time for a 34-yard, one-handed catch in coverage in the back of the end zone for the score. McGonigle was perfect again for the 28-7 lead.

The Falcons had their best scoring opportunity in the third quarter as they went 40 yards on eight plays to get to the Bloomsburg 30-yard line. Charles Crews III (Williamsport, Pa./Williamsport Area) and John Aston (Centre Hall, Pa./Penns Valley) pushed the Falcons back on their past play of the drive with an eight-yard sack on 3rd-and-10. Emmanual Richardson pulled his 47-yard field goal attempt wide left.

Bloomsburg answered the drive with a scoring drive to take a 35-7 lead in the third. After starting on their 30-yard line, Williams ran the ball four straight times to get the Huskies down to the Bloomsburg 41-yard line. Ries ran it for another 15 yards and Parker took it the rest of the way for his first-career touchdown with Bloomsburg, a 39-yard run with 6:09 to play in the third. McGonigle's kick made it 35-7 Huskies.

McGonigle's ensuing kickoff was fumbled by Farrow at the Bloomsburg 40-yard line and the Huskies took over once again. Bloomsburg bled the clock and got down to the FSU 2-yard line as the quarter ended. Ries' only blemish on the day came on the first play of the fourth quarter as Howard Williams picked off a pass to the far left corner for a touchback.

No harm was done as the Huskies forced a quick 3-and-out on the next drive and took over with 14:29 to play in the fourth. Bloomsburg turned the ball over on downs at the FSU-1 yard line but took six minutes off the clock when they gave the ball back. The Falcons put together an 11-play drive to get to the Bloomsburg 26-yard line but turned it over on downs once again as Cole Turner (Royersford, Pa./Spring-Ford) pushed Jermaine Bradford out of bounds just before the first down marker.

Bloomsburg got the ball back with 4:41 to play and got down to the Bloomsburg 36-yard line before Riley punted it away and the Huskies downed the ball on the Fairmont State 18-yard line with 17 seconds to play. The Falcons ran one final play before the clock hit zero for the Bloomsburg win.

McGonigle was a perfect 5-for-5 on extra point attempts in his return to the lineup after missing most of the 2023 season due to an injury.

Thompson led the defensive effort for Bloomsburg with eight tackles, including 0.5 TFL (3 yards). Turner and Ryan D'Ambra (Southampton, Pa./Archbishop Wood) each had six tackles while Nate Capers (Royersford, Pa./Spring-Ford) broke up a pair of passes and Idriz Ahmetovic (New Oxford, Pa./New Oxford) had a pass breakup in his Bloomsburg debut.
