THE GAME

The Huskies come into Saturday's game looking to build momentum after an impressive 32-27 come-from-behind win over Edinboro last week. The Huskies trailed 12-0 late in the second quarter before mounting three different comebacks to take the win and improve to 2-1 on the year. The Golden Rams come into the game on a three-game losing streak to open the season. Last week, Seton Hill scored 13 unanswered points in the fourth quarter to win 27-24 over WCU.

SCOUTING WEST CHESTER

The Golden Rams are led offensively by two-way threat, Cooper Jordan. Jordan has taken every snap under center for WCU and has 644 passing yards and is 45-for-81 with five interceptions and four touchdown passes. He has a long pass of 84 yards and is averaging 214.7 passing yards per game. Jordan is doing a lion share of the rushing as well with 198 yards on 48 carries and one touchdown.

Jordan's top target on the year is D'Shaun Seals with 20 catches for 314 yards and two touchdowns. He caught a long pass of 84 yards and is averaging 104.67 yards per game. Rahiem Bowens caught five passes for 87 yards and Robby Longo has six catches for 81 yards. The Golden Rams are averaging 14.31 yards per catch.

For the ground game, Dayshawn Jacobs is the second leading rusher for the Golden Rams with 68 yards on 10 carries and one touchdown. Jayden Williams has 60 yards on 21 carries and three of the Golden Rams' five rushing touchdowns. West Chester is averaging 4.0 yards per carry and 132.0 yards per game.

Defensively, Connor Noble leads West Chester with 30 total tackles, including 1.5 tackles for loss (3 yards), and one pass breakup. Shane Mosley is second on the team with 23 tackles, 0.5 TFL, and has three pass breakups and an interception which he returned for 17 yards. Mosley also has blocked a kick this season. Luke Trunell has 20 total tackles and, 1-0 TFL (2 yards), and a fumble recovery. Abdul Stewart leads the team with four pass breakups to go with his 14 tackles (1 TLF (3 yards)).

As a team, the Golden Rams have allowed 420.0 total yards of offense to opponents, including 237.3 yards in the air and 182.7 yards on the ground. Teams are converting third downs at a 34.1% rate (14-for-41) and are 7-for-11 (63%) on fourth down conversions. The Golden Rams have allowed nine rushing touchdowns and just two passing.

SCOUTING THE HUSKIES

The Huskies' defense continues to shine on Saturdays as Bloomsburg was carried by the defense through the first three quarters for the 32-27 win over Edinboro.

Leading the defensive effort for Bloomsburg is redshirt sophomore Brady Thompson with 26 total tackles, 3.5 TFL (15 yards) and 0.5 sacks (3 yards). He has one forced fumble as well. Ryan D'Ambra is second on the team with 25 tackles, 1.5 TFL (8 yards), 1.0 sacks (7 yards), a quarterback hurry. Nate Capers is off to a blistering start for the Huskies with 17 tackles, two pass break ups and a QB hurry. Fellow DB, Cole Turner, is fourth on the team with 17 tackles, 1.0 TFL (4 yards), one interception and three pass break ups. He has one forced and recovered fumble as well.

Tom Goetz, John Aston, and Ian Donohue all have 1.5 sacks for a combined 34 yards. Goetz has a pass break up and a QB hurry while Aston has 2.5 tackle for loss for 24 yards and a QB hurry. Donohue has two QB hurries as well.

The Huskies are allowing just 306.0 yards of offense per game to opposing teams, including just 62.3 yards per game on the ground and 243.67 passing yards. The Huskies have allowed just one rushing touchdown this season.

Offensively, the Huskies averaging 394.3 yards of total offense per game, split between 187.7 yards on the ground and 206.67 passing yards. Bloomsburg has eight rushing touchdowns and four passing scores.

Leading the rushing charge is true freshman Jake Williams. Williams has 230 net yards on the ground and has lost just three yards in 44 attempts. He has one rushing touchdown. Fellow freshman Riley Parker with 87 yards on the ground on 14 attempts. Parker has five rushing touchdowns this season and is averaging 6.2 yards per carry. As a team, the Huskies are averaging 4.5 yards a carry.

Ben Ries leads the team with 342 passing yards on the season behind 23-for-40 passing. Ries has two touchdown passes and has thrown four interceptions. KJ Riley is 16-for-21 passing with two touchdown passes and 278 yards, all of which came against Edinboro last Saturday for a career-passing day.

The top target of the Huskies quarterbacks is Gabe Brower with 219 yards on 14 catches and one touchdown catch. Jerry Griffen-Batchler has 203 yards on 11 catches and two touchdowns while Matthew Bowes has four catches for 105 yards. The Husky receivers are averaging 15.9 yards per catch.

As a team, the Huskies are 16-for-35 (45.71%) on third down conversions and 8-for-10 in red zone attempts with all eight scores are a touchdown.

ON THIS DAY – SEPTEMBER 28

Bloomsburg Football History, September 28, 2013

Senior running back Franklyn Quiteh (Tobyhanna/Pocono Mountain West) recorded another day for the record books as well – surpassing 6,000 yards for his career with a 205-yard performance on Saturday. The all-time PSAC leader in rushing yards needed just 11 carries to surpass the 200-yard plateau, also running for three touchdowns while hauling in another reception for a score. He finishes the day with 6,116 career rushing yards, moving into 13th all-time in Division II history.

The Huskies scored 20 or more points for the 17th consecutive game, tying the school record set between 2000-01 ... Hutton's three touchdowns marked a career high while Kelly tied his career-best with four scores ... Quiteh tied his personal best of four touchdowns ... Quiteh also rushed for over 100 yards in the first half for the 15th time in his career and finished with over 200 yards for the ninth time ... the Huskies had two 100-yard rushers for the third time this season after Quiteh and Munger did so vs. Stonehill and at Edinboro ... Bloomsburg extended its home winning streak over Lock Haven to nine games and holds a 45-38-3 all-time series lead over the Bald Eagles after 87 meetings, the most games played by Bloomsburg vs. any opponent.

SALUTE TO DANNY HALE

NCAA DII football coaching legend of the Bloomsburg Huskies, Danny Hale, has gotten the call for his rightful enshrinement in the College Football Hall of Fame as part of the 2024 Induction Class, as announced by the National Football Foundation (NFF) and ESPN on January of 2024. The Bloomsburg department of athletics in partnership with the Husky Legacy Club is honoring Coach Hale with the Salute to Danny Hale on Saturday.

Hale, one of the winningest coaches in all of NCAA Division II, retired June 28, 2013, after spending 20 seasons as the head coach of the Huskies and 25 years overall as a head coach. Hale also spent five years as head coach at West Chester University (1984-1988).

As part of the celebration, Bloomsburg athletics is hosting A Salute to Danny Hale, sponsored by the Husky Legacy Club (HLC) on Saturday, September 28 following the Huskies home football game against West Chester which kicks off at 2:00 pm at Danny Hale Field in Redman Stadium. The event is free to all attendees and registration is encouraged for all guests. The event will be held at Monty's in the Pettit Athletic Complex on upper campus of Bloomsburg.

PROTECTING THE QB

The offensive line was a bright spot for the Huskies in 2023. The Bloomsburg o-line allowed the fewest sacks of all the PSAC schools, letting the quarterback get sacked just 12 times in 12 games and giving back just 87 yards on the sacks. This season, the Huskies gave up just one sack against

Fairmont State but helped the rushing game to 284 yards on the ground.

The Huskies are seventh in the PSAC with seven sacks allowed for just 31 yards lost.

PLAYING A CLEAN GAME

The Huskies were the second-least penalized team in the PSAC last season. Bloomsburg was called for just 55 penalties which cost the Huskies just 522 yards, averaging just 43.5 yards per game. The least-penalized team was Kutztown with 53 flags for 453 yards and the most penalized team was Seton Hill which drew 112 flags for 1,027 yards.

This season, Bloomsburg is seventh in the conference in penalties with 22 for 173 yards, averaging 57.7 yards lost. The most penalized team so far is Clarion with 33 penalties for 264 yards and the least penalized team is Kutztown with 15 penalties for 160 yards and Gannon with 15 for 119 yards.

LET'S GO FOR IT

The Huskies went for it on 4th-down 16 times last season, converting nine of those attempts at a 56.3% clip. They were the fourth-best fourth-down conversion team in the PSAC last season behind California (Pa.) (8-13/61.5%), Slippery Rock (20-33/60.6%), and Edinboro (10-17/58.8). So far in 2024, the Huskies are just 0-1 on first downs, but are 16-for-35 on third down tries this season, which eliminated the need for fourth down tries.

I'M HONORED

Junior Jerry Griffen-Batchler (Norristown, Pa./Germantown Academy) earned the Huskies' first PSAC East Athlete of the Week honor as he was named the PSAC East Special Teams player of the Week after his Week 1 performance. He returned four punts for 70 yards and set the Huskies' up with short fields each time he returned the ball. The 70 punt return yards was a career single-game high for Griffen-Batchler. He finished the game with 150 all-purpose yards after pulling down four catches for 80 yards and two touchdowns.

The Huskies picked up two more Athlete of the Week honors as KJ Riley and Cole Turner were named the PSAC East Offensive and Defensive Athlete of the Week, respectively.

Riley went 16-for-21 with a career-best 278 yards and had two touchdown passes. Riley had a long touchdown pass of 55 yards, which was also a career-high. He ran

for another nine yards on four carries, engineered the first touchdown drive for the Huskies, and put together the game-winning 7-play, 75-yard drive that took 38 seconds in the fourth quarter to give the Husk-ies a 32-27 lead.

He did all the punting and one kickoff, as well. Riley had 260 punting yards, with a long of 58, averaged 43.3 yards per punt, and had two inside the 20 and 1 touchback. His punting yards, long punt, and average yards per punt were all career-highs for Riley—his one kickoff went for 35 yards.

Turner finished the day with 8.0 total tackles for the Huskies, along with a forced fumble, a fumble recovery, a broken-up pass, and an interception.

Turner's interception came as time expired in regulation to seal the 32-27 win for the Huskies on the Bloomsburg 1-yard line. It was Turner's first career pick and spoiled a game-winning Hail Mary attempt by the Fighting Scots.

THEY ARE FRESHMAN

A pair of true freshmen running backs are quickly making a name for themselves for the Huskies. Freshman Jake Williams leads the team with 230 net rushing yards and one touchdown on 44 carries in three games. Williams is averaging 5.2 yards per carry and 76.67 yards per game. Classmate Riley Parker has 87 rushing yards on 14 carries but leads the team and is second in the PSAC with five rushing touchdowns. Parker is averaging 6.2 yards per carry.

THE RILEY FILE

Junior KJ Riley came in the second quarter against Edinboro and led the Huskies to come-from-behind 32-27 win last Saturday. Riley is 16-for-21 with two touchdowns and 278 yards passing. For his career, Riley is 196-for-340 with 15 touchdown passes and 2,567 passing yards in 24 games.

Riley also handles the punting duties for the Huskies this season with 14 punts for 550 yards, averaging 39.3 yards per punt. He has one touchback, three fair catches, and seven landed inside the 20-yard line with one going for 50+ yards.

THE RIES FILE

Ben Ries took over under center last season and finished out the year strong for the Huskies. In eight games, he went 68-for-125 with one touchdown and three interceptions. He threw for 747 yards, averaging 11.0 yards per play and 93.4 yards per game. Ries ran for another 97 yards on 47 attempts and two touchdowns. For his career, Ries is 101-for-192 with three touchdowns and seven interceptions and 1,146 yards. Ries has 284 yards on the ground on 94 rushing attempts in three seasons with the Huskies.

This season, Ries is 23-for-40 with 342 passing yards and two touchdowns. Ries has run for another six yards and a touchdown so far in 2024.

NO FLY ZONE

The Bloomsburg defensive backs made a statement last year and allowed the fewest passing yards to opponents in the PSAC and were ranked 11th in NCAA DII. The Huskies allowed just 152.55 yards per game to opposing quarterbacks and collected 10 interceptions. The longest passing play the Huskies allowed last season was just 39 yards. In total, Bloomsburg had 31 broken up passes for the year and hurried the quarterback 27 times.

Returning in the secondary for Bloomsburg is Ron Long (Philadelphia, Pa./Archbishop Ryan) (44 tackles, 2 INT, 1 QBH), Ervin Mitchell (Waldorf, Md./Westlake) (6 tackles, 1 INT, 1 PBU), Devin Fleming (Manassas, Va./Osbourne Park) (34 tackles, 4 PBU), and Nate Capers (Royersford, Pa./Spring-Ford) (39 tackles, 2 PBU, 2 QBH).

Capers showed off again in the first game of the season with seven tackles, a pair of pass break ups and a quarterback hurry. Taking on a bigger role in the secondary is Cole Turner (Royersford, Pa./Spring-Ford) who turned in five tackle and a pass break up against Fairmont State. Freshman Idriz Ahmetovic (New Oxford, Pa./New Oxford) had a pass break up as well in his Husky debut.

Turner leads the team with three pass breakups and had the game-sealing interception last Saturday against Edinboro. The redshirt sophomore has 17 total tackles, 1.0 TFL (4 yards), a forced fumble, and a fumble recovery this season.

The pass game is allowing 243.67 yards per game to opposing quarterbacks but just five touchdown passes and just 6.59 yards per pass attempt.

STIFLE THE RUN

The Huskies are the third-best team in the PSAC against the run. Bloomsburg is allowing just 62.3 yards per game and just 2.1 yards per carry in the first three games. They have allowed just one rushing touchdown this season. A crucial part of stopping the run for the Huskies in the defensive line's ability to penetrate the line of scrimmage and make tackles in the backfield. The Huskies have 19.0 TFL for a loss of 96 yards this season. Leading that charge is Brady Thompson with 3.5 TFL (15 yards) and John Aston with 2.5 TFL (24 yards).

Fairmont State came into the season opening game with 208 yards on the ground in their week 0 game and five touchdowns. Bloomsburg brought the boom and stopped the Falcons run game, allowing just 62 yards on the ground and no touchdowns. The Falcons had 80 yards on 20 carries, but the Huskies had 2.0 TFL for 18 yards.

Seton Hill was limited to just 85 yards on the ground on 40 attempts and one touchdown last week.

Edinboro's run game was halted by the Huskies as the Fighting Scots had just 40 net rushing yards on 27 attempts. The Huskies had collected 17 yards on tackles for loss. Bloomsburg allowed just 1.5 yards per carry.

LBU

The Huskies' linebackers have been a force to be reckoned with since the Frank Sheptock days, and the 2024 group is no different. Leading the way are seniors Ryan D'Ambra and Tom Goetz. D'Ambra led the Huskies with 90 total tackles last season and have 5.0 tackles for loss (19 yards) and 2.0 sacks (15 yards). He hit the quarterback four other times and blocked one kick. D'Ambra broke up four passes as well. D'Ambra has 160 tackles in his

QUICK RECAP – 2023 GOLDEN RAMS

West Chester finished last season 6-5 and 3-4 in PSAC East action. The Rams got off to a quick start with a 20-19 win over Bentley but fell to Slippery Rock 49-24. West Chester defeated Gannon 38-31 before falling to Millersville 23-14. The Golden Rams strung together two-straight wins with a 24-21 overtime win over Bloomsburg and a 38-28 win over Shippensburg. West Chester fell to East Stroudsburg (28-14) and Shepherd (59-21) before defeating Lock Haven 42-27. After a 27-17 loss to Kutztown, the Golden Rams closed out the year with a 34-7 win over Clarion.

COACHING STAFF UPDATES

Head coach Frank Sheptock has announced several updates to his staff ahead of the 2024 season. The Huskies welcomed Tim Landis, offensive coordinator, to Bloomsburg ahead of spring practice while Zach Martin (defensive coordinator & linebackers), Greg Kahn (defensive line), and Johnathan Pruden (defensive backs) joined the Huskies this summer. Previous student assistant Josh Bernocco was elevated to wide receivers coach and special teams coordinator following spring practices.

The Huskies will take the field on Thursday without all-conference running back Kaleb Monaco. Monaco led the team with 952 yards on the ground last season and ran in six touchdowns. He averaged 5.1 yards per carry and 86.55 yards per game. Monaco had 1,658 all-purpose yards for the year.

Star defensive back Quentin Gaskill graduated last fall after a stellar career for the Huskies. Last season, he was second on the team with 76 tackles and had six broken up passes, two interceptions, and a blocked kick. For his career, Gaskill accumulated 279 tackles, 10.5 TLF (47 yards), 3.0 sacks (27 yards), six interceptions, 28 passes defended, five forced fumbles (three recoveries), and three blocked kicks. Gaskill played in 43 out of 44 possible games during his time in the maroon and gold.

career so far.

Goetz, an all-PSAC linebacker, was third on the team with 76 tackles, including 3.0 tackles for loss (9 yards). He had two interceptions, one broken up pass, and three quarterback hurries. For his career, Goetz has 139 tackles in 26 games over the last three seasons. His 2022 season was shortened by an early-season injury. Goetz has 14 TFL (55 yards) and 6.5 sacks (38 yards).

Brady Thompson (Green Lane, Pa./Upper Perkiomen) made his presence known in his first season with the Huskies last year. He had 67 tackles, including 5.0 tackles for loss (11 yards) and 0.5 sacks (2 yards). Thompson had three quarterback hurries to his credit and once forced fumble.

The Huskies brought in seven new linebackers in their 2024 recruiting class to continue the tradition – Nick Farrell (Dallas, Pa./Dallas), Garrett Garcia (Catawissa, Pa./Southern Columbia), Brady Ronan (Tyrone, Pa./Tyrone Area), Connor Rickabaugh (Coatesville, Pa./Coatesville Area), Brady Mizenko (Sugarloaf, Pa./Hazleton Area), Nahzier Booker (Pottstown, Pa./Pottstown), and Rocco Serafini (Mill Hall, Pa./Central Mountain).

This season, Thompson is leading the Huskies with 26 total tackles, including a team-best 3.5 TFL (15 yards), and has 0.5 sacks for three yards. Thompson also forced one fumble this year. D'Ambra is second on the team with 25 total tackles and leads the Huskies with 11 solo stops. D'Ambra has 1.5 TFL (8 yards) and 1.0 sacks (7 yards), and a quarterback hurry. Goetz is sixth on the defense with 13 total tackles, second with 2.5 TFL (12 yards), and tied for the team lead with 1.5 sacks (11 yards). Goetz has a pass breakup and a quarterback hurry.

TUCKER HONORED BY THE GIANTS

Former All-Pro tight end Bob Tucker, a one-time Mountaineer and Bloomsburg State College football player, went undrafted and played semi-pro football before the Giants signed him as a free agent ahead of the 1970 season.

One year later, the 6-foot-3, 230-pounder became the first tight end in NFL history to lead the league in pass receptions in a season with 59 for 791 yards. Through 1977, Tucker also had seasons with 55, 50, 42, 41 and 40 catches on Giants teams that often found themselves looking up at the Dallas Cowboys, Washington Redskins and even the St. Louis Cardinals in the rugged NFC East.

In 1978, he was traded to the Minnesota Vikings, where he was reunited with his former Giants teammate, Hall of Fame quarterback Fran Tarkenton. Tucker spent a few seasons with the Vikings before retiring in 1980 and ultimately returning to Hazleton.

Tucker finished his 11-year NFL career 422 receptions for 5,421 yards and 27 touchdowns.

Giants are set to honor Tucker as 43rd best player in team history.

RETURNING ALL-PSAC ATHLETES

The Huskies return a pair of all-PSAC players in senior linebacker Tom Goetz (Wenonah, N.J./Gateway Regional) and senior defensive lineman Giovanni Cancro (Pequannock, N.J./Pequannock Township). Cancro earned his first career postseason honor as a second-team defensive lineman. The Pequannock, N.J. native had a breakout year for the Huskies with 29 total tackles this year, including 15 solo stops. He had 5.0 tackles for a loss of 22 yards and broke up two passes. Cancro finished with one quarterback hurry and a blocked kick.

Goetz had an exceptional comeback season for the Huskies in 2023 after playing in just four games before a season-ending injury in 2022. Goetz had a career-best 76 tackles, 9.5 tackles for loss (34 yards), and 4.5 sacks (23 yards). The Wenonah, N.J. native had a pair of interceptions and three pass breakups for the year. Both of his INTs came against Clarion – one that was recovered for a touchdown and the second to seal the win for the Huskies late in the fourth quarter. He led the team in tackles for loss and sacks.

WELCOME TO BLOOM

Bloomsburg added 36 newcomers to the program on National Signing Day including six defensive backs, three defensive linemen, seven linebackers, a long snapper, five offensive linemen, a kicker, four quarterbacks, three running backs, two tight ends, and four wide receivers. The Huskies brought in players from two different states, including Pennsylvania (28), and New Jersey (8). The Huskies welcome four transfers to the roster this season. Spencer Branin from Southern Connecticut State, Ben Paserk from Lackawanna, Infinite Campbell from Lock Haven, and Malik McLaurin from Monroe.

SHEPTOCK ERA

Sheptock was named the 28th head football coach in Bloomsburg University as he returns to his alma mater to take over the Huskies' program. Sheptock was at Division III Wilkes University as the defensive coordinator from 1990-95 and then took over the Colonels' program and served as head coach from 1996-2014. While at Wilkes, Sheptock went 107-81 overall and established the program record for most wins in a season (11) and career (107) while leading the Colonels to nine postseason appearances.

A member of the NCAA Division II Team of the Quarter Century (1973-97), Sheptock played linebacker for head coach George Landis and holds the school records for tackles in a career (537), single-season (159), and single-game (23), as well as career fumble recoveries (12). His program record for tackles in a single game, in fact, occurred during the national semifinal contest at North Alabama.

Area) in the back corner of the endzone for the game-tying touchdown. The score capped a six-play 71-yard drive by the Huskies. Bloomsburg started the drive from their own 29-yard line after a missed 46-yard field goal by the WCU kicker. Junior Kaleb Monaco (Pocono Pines, Pa./Pocono Mountain West) got the ball on the first two plays and went 11 yards for a Husky first down. Riley got the Huskies into West Chester territory with a 23-yard pass to redshirt sophomore Jerry Griffen-Batchler (Norristown, Pa./Germantown Academy). Monaco went another 17 yards on two more carries to get the Huskies down to the West Chester 27-yard line before Riley connected with Jones for a 20-yard score. Christopher George (Ashley, Pa./Hanover Area) connected on his point after kick to tie the game 21-21 with 3:28 to play.

West Chester got a first down before Ryan D'Ambra (Southampton, Pa./Archbishop Wood) sacked the quarterback for a loss of seven yards back to the West Chester 34-yard line. The Golden Rams got 11 yards back on their next pass and faced a 3rd-and-6 from the West Chester 45-yard line. Cooper Jordan held on to the ball and ran it himself but Joseph Kahn (Selinsgrove, Pa./Selinsgrove) knocked it out. A West Chester player recovered it beyond the first down marker to give new life to the Golden Rams. West Chester got down to the Bloomsburg 8-yard line and Tom Goetz (Wenonah, N.J./Gateway Regional) sacked Jordan for a loss of five yards back to the Bloom-13. With just three seconds on the clock, the Golden Rams had no choice but to attempt the field goal but WCU missed the 30-yard attempt and the game headed to overtime.

After a quick first down, the Golden Rams found themselves at the Bloomsburg 20-yard line after a false start. A short three-yard gain on a pass got them down to the 17 but two-straight incomplete passes put the Golden Rams at a 4th-and-12 from the Bloomsburg 17. Sean Henry's 34-yard attempt was good and WCU took a 24-21 lead.

The Golden Rams' defense held strong during the Huskies' overtime possession and forced a 4th-and-15 from the West Chester 30-yard line which Bloomsburg did not convert. West Chester held on for the 24-21 win.

Bloomsburg opened the game with a 10-play, 65-yard drive that took 5:49 off the clock and ended with Monaco scampering five yards into the endzone for the score. After George hit the PAT, the Huskies led 7-0. Two drives later, the Huskies were forced to punt and D'Shaun Seals caught the kick at the West Chester 30-yard line and returned the punted 60 yards for a touchdown and to tie the game 7-7.

With 5:04 remaining in the second quarter, the Golden Rams took their first lead 14-7 as Brody McAndrew had a three-yard run in for the score.

After Monaco returned the kickoff 19 yards to the Bloomsburg 36-yard line, Riley hit Jones for a 15-yard pass for a Husky first down before he connected with Owen Anderson (Cogan Station, Pa./Jersey Shore Area) for a 39-yard play that got the Huskies down to the WCU 10-yard line. A quick four-yard run for Monaco set up the sweep play for Griffen-Batchler to go six yards on the ground to the left and the score. George hit the point after and tied the game 14-14 with 2:49 to play in the half.

The Huskies' defense forced a punt on West Chester's next possession and time expired while the Huskies' drove the field to send the teams into halftime tied, 14-14.

The Golden Rams took the opening kick off of the second half and put together a seven-play 60-yard drive that ended with Jordan getting into the endzone with a nine-yard run to give WCU a 21-14 lead.

It remained a one-score game after a fumble and two punts between the two teams got the game into the final minutes of regulation before Jones' game-tying touchdown with 3:28 to play.

For the game, Monaco led all players with 108 yards on the ground and had his third 100-yard rushing game of the season. Riley went 16-for-25 for 207 yards and one touchdown while Anderson caught five passes for 65 yards and Griffen-Batchler caught five passes for 61 yards. Jones finished the day with four catches for 53 yards.

Quentin Gaskill (Waynesboro, Pa./Waynesboro) led the defense with nine tackles while D'Ambra had eight stops including a sack for the loss of seven yards. He forced a fumble as well. Brady Thompson (Green Lane, Pa./Upper Perkiomen) had another strong game for Bloomsburg with eight tackles, including 1.5 tackle for a loss of four yards, 0.5 sacks for two yards and a forced fumble.

LAST TIME OUT - BLOOM at Edinboro (September 21, 2024)

EDINBORO, Pa. – A late second-quarter touchdown run sparked the Bloomsburg offense as the Huskies rallied from a 12-point first-half deficit for the 32-27 win over Edinboro Saturday. The lead changed hands three times in the final 5:44 of the fourth quarter and the Huskies defense came up with a crucial interception at the goal line to seal the win.

With 5:44 to play in regulation and the game tied, 20-20, the Bloomsburg defense forced a vital 3-and-out by the Edinboro offense and the Huskies took over at their 30-yard line after a 46-yard punt with 4:44 to play. Jake Williams (Myerstown, Pa./ELCO) took the first hand off of the drive and went two yards before junior KJ Riley (Danville, Pa./Danville Area) found Jerry Griffen-Batchler (Norristown, Pa./Germantown Academy) for nine yards down the left sideline to get a first down. Riley carried the ball on the next play to pick up four yards. On the next play from scrimmage, Riley found senior Gabe Brower (Alexandria, Pa./Juniata Valley) at midfield who broke a tackle and got to the outside. Brower was off to the races down the right sideline in front of the Edinboro bench to get to the end zone for a 55-yard touchdown catch. The extra point attempt was blocked, and the Huskies took a 26-20 lead with 2:25 to play in regulation. The touchdown catch capped a four-play 70-yard drive for the Huskies.

Edinboro had a quick answer to the Huskies touchdown drive with a five-play, 71-yard scoring drive. Evan Low caught a 44-yard pass from Isaac Bernard with 1:12 to play and the Fighting Scots converted the extra point kick for a 27-26 lead.

With 1:12 to play, Riley stayed calm in the pocket and completed a 24-yard pass and a 14-yard pass to Griffen-Batchler to get down to the Edinboro 37-yard line. Riley found Brower again for a 17-yard reception to get to the BORO-20 and the third-straight first down of the drive. Riley found Griffen-Batchler at the BORO-12 for an eight-yard pickup. Riley kept it himself to get two yards and the first down before head coach Frank Sheptock called his first timeout with 43 seconds to play. It then became the Riley Parker (Canton, Pa./Canton) show. Parker carried the ball down to the one-yard line before stepping out of bounds to stop the clock. Riley then handed the ball back off to Parker for an outside run around anyone looking to get in his way as he ran into the end zone for the score and the 32-27 Bloomsburg lead with 34 seconds to play. The Huskies tried for two to give them a seven-point cushion, but a flag brought back the catch by Matthew Bowes (Somerton, Pa./La Salle College HS) and the next attempt failed.

Coach Sheptock sent his defensive unit out and asked for one more stop. Riley kicked off for 35 yards to the BORO-30 when Edinboro took over with 32 seconds to play.

On the first play from scrimmage, Bernard completed a pass to Angelo Bartolini for four yards before he found Low for another 11 and to get down close to midfield. Pressure from Sean Paul (Roselle, N.J./Hudson Catholic) and a charging Ryan D'Ambra (Southampton, Pa./Archbishop Wood) forced Bernard to throw it away and stop the clock with nine seconds to play. Bernard completed a pass to Jaret Frantz at the Bloomsburg 43-yard line to move the chains. Edinboro brought in their backup quarterback, Bo Swartz for the Hail Mary pass attempt but Cole Turner (Royersford, Pa./Spring-Ford) jumped the route and grabbed his first career interception to seal the win for Bloomsburg at the one-yard line.

Despite a sluggish start for the Bloomsburg offense, the defense kept the Huskies in the game and the score close. Bloomsburg began the game on the Edinboro 48-yard line but could not get a first down and was forced to punt from the 43-yard line.

The Fighting Scots started their first drive at their 12-yard line and marched down the field to the BLOOM-6. A pair of Swartz passes fell incomplete, and Turner got the stop at the line of scrimmage on a Jerry Dinkins run to turn the ball over on downs.

The Huskies went 3-and-out again and needed another big play from their defense. After the Fighting Scots got back down to the Huskies' two-yard line, Dinkins rushed up in the middle for what looked to be a one-yard gain and lost control of the ball after his knee was down. Coach Sheptock challenged the play and won the challenge. Brady Thompson (Green Lane, Pa./Upper Perkiomen) forced the fumble on Dinkins' run and Turner recovered the loose ball in the end zone for a Huskies touchback.

The Huskies' next drive started with just 52 seconds to play in the quarter and ended with another Husky punt with 14:06 left in the second. The Fighting Scots brought the pressure on the punt and Gage Galuska blocked it and recovered the ball in the end zone for the score and the 6-0 Edinboro lead. Giovanni Cancro (Pequannock, N.J./Pequannock Township) returned the favor and blocked the extra point attempt to keep the score 6-0.

After three more punts, two from Bloomsburg and one for Edinboro, the Fighting Scots finally got an offensive score with a four-yard touchdown pass from Bernard to Jaret Frantz, but the Fighting Scots elected to go for two and Bernard's pass fell short. The next Husky drive ended with an Edinboro interception, but the Huskies' defense came up swinging again.

Bloomsburg had the Fighting Scots 4th-and-7 on the BLOOM-42 and Edinboro ran a fake punt as Matt Carlisle completed a pass to Reed Martin for a first down. But after a three-yard run for Dinkins, D'Ambra sacked Bernard for a loss of seven yards and Ryan Woertz (Philadelphia, Pa./Archbishop Wood) broke up Bernard's next pass to force a 4th-and-14 from the Bloomsburg-33. The Fighting Scots went for it and Teagan Brown caught a pass from Bernard but D'Ambra and Ervin Mitchell (Waldorf, Md./Westlake) brought him down seven yards shy of the first down and gave the ball back to the Huskies' offense.

The fourth-down stop sparked Bloomsburg as the Huskies went 74 yards on eight plays to find the end zone for the first time in the contest. Riley found Owen Anderson (Cogan Station, Pa./Jersey Shore Area) for three yards before taking a sack. Riley targeted Bowes on his next pass and Edinboro was called for pass interference to put the ball on the Bloomsburg 43 and a Husky first down. Riley connected with Anderson again for 20 yards down to the BORO-42. After a four-yard run for Riley and a Husky penalty, Bloomsburg was set up at the Edinboro-43 on 2nd-and-11. Riley found Brower for six yards to the BORO-37 but a roughing the passer call against Edinboro added another 15 yards to move the ball down to the BORO-22. Brower caught another pass for five yards to the BORO-17 and a Edinboro holding penalty got the Huskies down to the BORO-8 with a fresh set of downs. Bloomsburg needed just one more play as Parker carried it the rest of the way for the score.

The Fighting Scots ran just one play to end to run out the clock in the first half as Edinboro led 12-6.

Bloomsburg forced a three-and-out on Edinboro's first drive of the second half and scored on their next drive to take their first lead of the game.

On 2nd-and-8 at the BORO-40, Riley found Bowes for 18 yards down to the Edinboro 22-yard line. Williams carried the ball twice down to the 13 and Parker took care of business for the second time in the game with an 11-yard run and score. Danen Lorusso (Moorestown, N.J./Roman Catholic) converted the extra point kick and Bloomsburg took a 13-12 lead.

Bloomsburg held onto the lead until 1:36 mark in the third when Edinboro put together an eight-play, 53-yard drive to re-take the lead 20-13.

Bloomsburg tied the game with 5:49 to play in the fourth thanks in part to an unnecessary roughness call against Edinboro kept the drive alive at 3rd-and-10 from the Bloomsburg 29-yard line. After the penalty, Riley found Brower for 38 yards down to the BORO-18. Williams ran it for a yard loss before Justin Wolfe (Hollidaysburg, Pa./Hollidaysburg Area) caught a 19-yard touchdown pass from Riley. Lorusso's kick was good to tie the game 20-20 with 5:44 to play before scoring frenzy in the final five minutes.

Riley finished the day 16-for-21 with 278 yards and two touchdown passes in his second appearance under center of the season. He had a long pass of 55 yards and was sacked just once. Brower had a career day with eight catches and 163 yards, catching one of the touchdown passes and having a long reception of 55 yards. Griffen-Batchler caught five passes for 64 yards and Anderson caught two for 23 yards in his 2024 debut. Wolfe caught two passes for 19 yards, one of which was a touchdown catch.

Williams ran the ball 16 times for 27 yards while Parker carried the ball just five times for 29 yards but three of his five carries were a touchdown.

Riley still took care of the punting duties for the Huskies and had six punts for 260 yards, with three pinning the Fighting Scots inside the 20-yard line and one touchback.

Defensively, the Huskies got big contributions from everyone. Thompson led the pack with a career-best 12 tackles, including 0.5 TFL (2 yards) and a forced fumble. Turner finished the day with eight tackles, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery, an interception, and a pass breakup. Freshman Nick Frame (Slatington, Pa./Northern Lehigh) grabbed his first career interception as well to go with five tackles. D'Ambra and Ian Donohue (Schuylkill Haven, Pa./Blue Mountain) had a solo sack and eight players combined for 7.0 total tackles for loss (23 yards). D'Ambra and Charles Crews III (Williamsport, Pa./Williamsport Area) each had 1.5 TFL.

As a team, the Huskies rushed for 83 net yards on 32 carries and three rushing TDs and were 4-for-4 on red-zone chances and scores.

Defensively, the Huskies held Edinboro to just 40 total yards on the ground and Edinboro was 5-for-17 on third-down chances and scored just one of three times in the red zone.=
