DIRECTIONS



Bloomsburg is located 75 miles from the PA/NJ border on Interstate 80.

Coming from ...

- **East:** Use I-80 west to Exit 236A. Merge right onto 487 south.

- **West:** Use I-80 east to Exit 236. Turn left at end of ramp.

- **South (Harrisburg area):** Take routes 11 and 15 north then to 487 north.

- **Southeast Pennsylvania:** Take Northeast Extension of the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-476) to I-80 west (Pocono Exit) to Exit 236A. Merge right onto 487 south.

- **North of Bloomsburg (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre area):** Take I-81 to I-80 west to Exit 236A.

- **Williamsport area:** Take I-180 south to I-80 east to Exit 236. Turn left at the end of the ramp.

From Exit 236 / 236A: Take route 487 south approximately two miles. Turn right at the traffic light onto Pettit and go up the hill for athletic facilities.

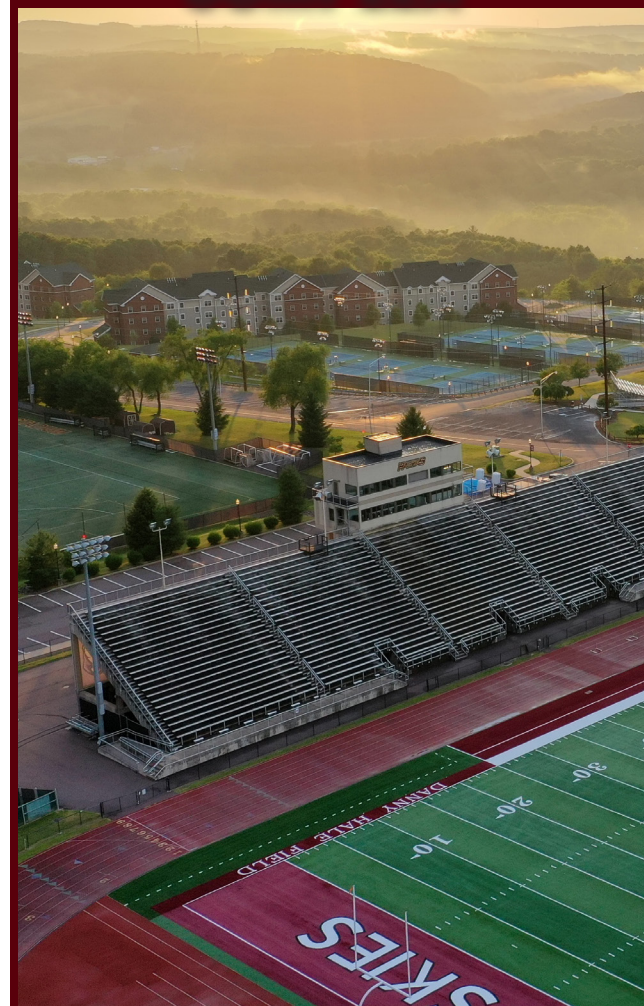
From South and West (Rt 11): Take route 487 north and turn left at first traffic light onto Pettit Way and go up the hill for athletic facilities.

For GPS Users: Type in 59 Pettit Way, Bloomsburg, PA, 17815, which will get you to the edge of Upper Campus where the Pettit Athletic Complex is located.

ATHLETIC TRAINING

The Bloomsburg athletic training staff will allow visiting teams access to: ice, water, an area for taping, and moist heat. Visiting teams must bring their own training supplies such as tape.

A team physician will be present for all home football games and wrestling matches as well as other selected contests. An ambulance will be on-site for all football games.

The training room facility is located on the lower level of the Nelson Field House. The facility is open two hours prior to a competition and will remain open for 30 minutes after a competition.

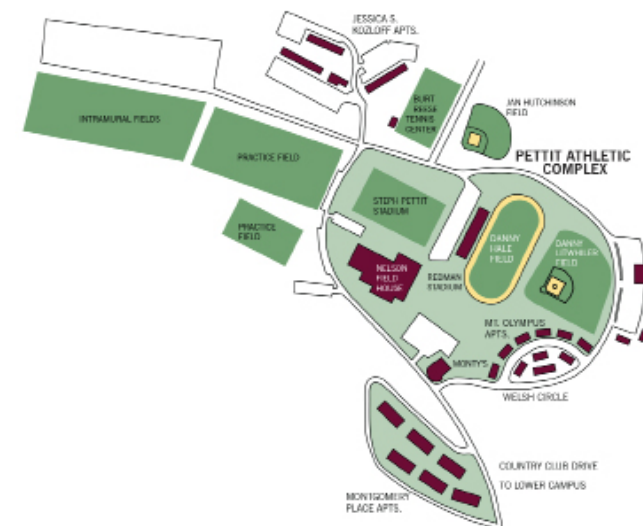

TICKETS

Bloomsburg charges admission at football, basketball, and wrestling - all other sports are free of charge. Visit buhuskies.com/tickets or call 570-389-3907 to purchase tickets in advance of the contest.

FOOTBALL

All tickets are general admission. Adults are \$10 and students/seniors (Age 62 and older) are \$5. Children five and under are free. Gates open two hours prior to event start time. Tickets can also be purchased at the main entrance to Redman Stadium.

BASKETBALL/WRESTLING

All tickets are general admission. Adults are \$10 and students/seniors (age 62 and older) are \$5. Children five and under are free. Doors open 90 minutes prior to event start time. Tickets can also be purchased at the main entrance to Nelson Field House.

Group discounts are available. Please call 570-389-3907 to make group arrangements.

NOTE

Ticket prices may vary during postseason play as prices are set by the PSAC, the MAC, or the NCAA. Students from BU and PSAC schools are admitted free to all PSAC playoff games with valid ID. The one exception is the PSAC football championship game, where ONLY Bloomsburg students with ID would be admitted for free.
