## THE MATCHUP

Tuesday's game will be the third meeting this season between the two teams. The Huskies dropped both games to the Golden Rams this season. Bloomsburg lost game one on the road by six and was then defeated at home by three points. West Chester is on an eight game winning streak.

## LAST MEETING

Bloomsburg dropped the last meeting between the teams at the Nelson Field House, 74-71. The Huskies held a four point lead at halftime but were limited to 29 points in the second half which resulted in a three point loss. Three BU players finished with double figures as Dontahe Jordan led the way with 16 points and 11 rebounds while Larry Webster added another double-double with 10 points and 10 boards.

## ALL-TIME SERIES

Bloomsburg leads the all-time series, 64-58.

## FIRST HALF EFFORT

In their last game, Bloomsburg put up 42 points in the first half against West Chester. It is their second highest amount scored in a first half this season. Earlier this year Bloomsburg scored 44 first half points against Edinboro.

## REBOUND MARGIN

West Chester and Bloomsburg rank in the top five in the PSAC in rebounding margin. West Chester is fourth with a margin of 3.2 and Bloomsburg is fifth with three. Both games this year produced two very different rebounding margins. In game one West Chester outrebounded the Huskies by nine but game two Bloomsburg outrebounded the Golden Rams by seven.

## DEFENDING THE PERIMETER

In their last game, West Chester knocked down nine three pointers, their most in a single game this season. This season, BU is fifth in the conference in defending the three ball, holding opponents to 31.7% shooting from beyond the arc. However, the Golden Rams rank third in the conference in three point shooting percentage (37%).

## NOT SINCE 1975-76

Bloomsburg has dished out 10 assists or more in each game this season. Last year BU had 10 assists or more in 17-of-26 games. It is the first time since the 1975-76 season that Bloomsburg has had at least 10 assists in every game.

## 20+ TURNOVERS

Against Millersville, the Huskies forced 20 turnovers by the Marauders. It is the third time this season Bloomsburg has done so, going 3-0 in those games. Last year BU was 3-1 when forcing 20 plus turnovers.

## BU'S LAST THREE

Bloomsburg's last three games have been decided by two points or fewer. Two of the three were decided by last second made baskets; one was a loss to Kutztown and the other a win over East Stroudsburg.

## FROM DOWNTOWN

Against Millersville, Bloomsburg made seven three pointers. Bloomsburg is 7-4 when making seven or more three pointers in a game. They are 13-4 when making six or more and a perfect 6-0 when making just six. The Huskies are first in the PSAC in three point shooting percentage making 37.6% of their attempts.

## NEVER LOST TO WEST CHESTER

The Huskies have some history on their side entering Tuesday's playoff game. Bloomsburg has never lost to the Golden Rams in the PSAC playoffs. BU is 3-0 against West Chester with wins in 2001, 1984, and 1983.

## A LITTLE MORE HISTORY ON THEIR SIDE

Bloomsburg has never lost a PSAC quarterfinal game in their history. The Huskies are 5-0 in quarterfinal games and own a 20-16 record in the PSAC playoffs.

## HOW ABOUT THIS

The last time BU was in the PSAC playoffs was in 2001-02 season. Guess who the Huskies played in the quarterfinals? That's right, it was the Golden Rams of West Chester, a game that the Huskies won 60-54.

## AND THIS...

During the 2001-02 season Bloomsburg lost both regular season games to West Chester. Both losses came by less than 10 points but in the PSAC tournament the Huskies came through for their first win of the season against West Chester.

## SCHWARZ OFF THE BENCH

Senior John Schwarz provided a spark off the bench against Millersville. He came in to score 12 first half points along with five rebounds in the half.

## HELD TO 30 REBOUNDS

Against Millersville, the Huskies grabbed just 30 rebounds, their fourth lowest amount of the season. It is the sixth time this season Bloomsburg has grabbed 30 or less rebounds in a game.

## FOUR STRAIGHT

Bloomsburg has shot the ball from beyond the arc 50% or better in their last four games. The Huskies went 3-1 in those games and are 6-1 this season when shooting 50% or better. BU's only loss came against Kutztown.

## UNFAMILIAR GROUND

Tuesday's playoff game will be a first for all the members of the men's team. The playoff appearance ends a 10 year absence from the postseason.

## NOT SINCE 1999

Bloomsburg is hosting their first home PSAC playoff game since the 1998-99 season. During that season, the Huskies hosted each round of the playoffs as they reached the championship game. BU eventually lost in finals to California Pa., 75-64.

## GOING FOR WIN NUMBER 20

Bloomsburg is sitting on 19 wins entering Tuesday's game. BU's current 19-8 record is their best showing since the 2000-01 season when the Huskies went 20-8. If Bloomsburg is able to win against West Chester, it will be the 10th time in program history with 20 or more wins.

## 1,000 POINT SCORERS

BU's Larry Webster and Trevon Johnson have each scored 1,000 career points. Both players reached the milestone this season making it the first time two BU players have done it in the same season since the 2002-03 season.
